Follow these easy steps:

1. At home, separate your recycling – put plastics, cartons and aluminum cans into bags, put glass beverage containers into boxes. Don't forget to include milk containers!
2. Visit a SARCAN Depot and look for Drop & Go – *for a full list of locations, see below.*
3. Follow instructions on the screen. Type **Willow Awards** when prompted to enter the group phrase. It is simple!
4. The amount of your order will be processed and paid directly to the **Saskatchewan Young Readers' Choice Awards – The Willow Awards.**

The group phrase works at all 72 depots across the province, so your friends and family across Saskatchewan can donate too!
