CFLA's Intellectual Freedom Committee is searching for four new members. We welcome nominations from CFLA member associations and interested individuals who are members of a CFLA/FCAB member association. Once appointed to the Committee, the responsibility of members is to the Committee, not to the nominating body.

The Committee strives to include a wide variety of backgrounds and interests, uniting individuals who value the principles of intellectual freedom and their application in the present context. The Committee is particularly interested in nominations from individuals from school libraries, academic libraries, government libraries, from the middle and eastern part of the country, and those who bring a francophone perspective.

Appointments will be made for a term of three years, renewable once.

The Committee will normally meet monthly between September and June, with additional meetings scheduled as required. For 2022-2023, the meetings will occur on the fourth Thursday of the month at 9:00am PST (10:00am MST or 12:00pm EST). The Intellectual Freedom Committee is a working committee. All members are expected to attend meetings, advance plenary activities, and contribute to two or more working groups.
