Meeting with Deputy Premier Wyant on February 6, 2020

The agenda included: Information Sharing and Updates, Funding Considerations and Communications. Testimonials from patrons are powerful messages to other potential patrons, as well as community and provincial leaders.

SLA to Participate in an Advisory Committee: Interventions to Enhance Social Inclusion of Older Adults with Dementia in Saskatchewan.

A research project is being conducted through the Saskatchewan Population Health and Evaluation Research Unit (SPHERU), a bi university research center at the University of Regina and the University of Saskatchewan. The research team has received a 5-year grant from eth New Horizons for Seniors Program of Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC). The project is aimed at improving the lives of older adults living with dementia in small cities and rural communities in Saskatchewan. SLA has been asked to participate on an Advisory Committee to support and guide the project. Regional Library systems may be asked to be involved in the project.

Communications Strategy Development Continues

SLA has engaged consultants to assist with development of a Communications Strategy. The Board will be joined by additional SLA members for a facilitated session in early March. We look forward to reporting results.
