Fiery Joe: The Maverick Who Lit Up the West

A man of grit and determination, Joseph Phelps used his term in government to overcome hard economic times and implement greater gains for all. A charismatic politician, Phelps planned Saskatchean provincial Crown Corporations, fought for the family farm, conserved northern forests, established northern air strips, brought electrification to rural areas, advocated for Indigenous hunting, fishing, and trapping, spoke up on women's rights, and initiated the first non-military government air ambulance service. Most of all, Phelps managed Saskatchewan's natural resources wisely to bring quality health care and education to all. But his unrelenting push for change alienated many. and Phelps served only one term; he was not asked to run again.
