

Government Seeks Public Input on the Saskatchewan Public Libraries Engagement Report

The report is divided into eight themes which reflect what the panel heard: Funding Structure and Predictability; Provincial Public Library Strategic Plan; “One Card, One Province”; Communication; Governance Training; Indigenization; Value of Public Libraries; and Legislation. Government is inviting public input through an online survey. The window for submitting input is narrow between January 10 and January 25 online.
