

THE PROJECT

By engaging Saskatchewan residents with their communities through a shared story, **ONE BOOK, ONE PROVINCE SASKATCHEWAN** aims to support literacy, to create a reading culture, and to raise the profile of libraries and literacy organizations in the province. One Book, One Province will also help to facilitate cross-organizational collaboration in planning, promotion, and programs.

In 2017, the Saskatchewan Library Association (SLA) will partner with the University of Regina Press to bring One Book, One Province to Saskatchewan readers as part of SLA's 75th Anniversary. The inaugural book, **THE EDUCATION OF AUGIE MERASTY**, was chosen for its potential to promote tolerance and understanding, while appealing to a broad, diverse, and contemporary audience. One Book, One Province will run in February and March of 2017. Details will be available in advance of its launch.
