All received submissions will receive a chronological number. At the deadline one submission will be randomly chosen by SLA's executive director using a number generator. If there is an incorrect answer then another submission will be randomly selected.

Eligibility

Those who currently hold SLA membership (individual, institutional, and associate) and are in good standing with the association can participate. Current members of the board of directors and SLA staff are ineligible.

11. Name the top three affiliated institutions that a majority of SLA presidents have come from. Hint: count a person once even if s/he has held the position more than one term. Who is allowed to submit and move a resolution at the AGM?
12. When were individual membership fees and salary ranges most recently updated?

13. How many networks have been established by SLA members? How many categories of continuing education grants does SLA offer to its members?
