SERP Training and Promotion Survey

The <u>Saskatchewan Electronic Resources Partnership</u> (<u>SERP</u>) is a province-wide program in which partner libraries pool funds to purchase access to digital resources: magazines, journals, newspapers, reference books, and other information resources.

SERP has heard, through focus groups and other conversations with multiple library sectors, that training and promotion are desired. The SERP Planning and Development Committee (PDC) committed to survey all program partners about training and promotion needs. This short 5-minute survey to collect feedback in a focused way will help us aggregate feedback from SERP partners across all sectors.
