Red Light intentional academic time set apart with your child Example: Learning to do Math at Home with Stacy Greener on YouTube	Title: Animal Cracker Counting Materials: Animal crackers, paper and markers. Directions: Write numbers 1 – 4 on the paper. Have your child place that amount of crackers next to each number.	Match that letter Materials: letters drawn on paper and letters written on sticky notes. Instructions: Have the child match the letters of the sticky notes with the letters on the paper.	Title: Shape Sorting Materials: Masking tape or chalk Directions: Using masking tape (or chalk if outdoors), outline shapes such as squares, triangles, circle, etc. Invite your child to find objects that match the shape and place them in the outline.	Activity: Recognizing Letters Helping children talk about letters we see in our surroundings, ex: " I wonder what letters we can find on this box of cereal", or the newspaper ads, food items etc... and have children color, cut and/or glue letters on a separate piece of paper to make activity more appealing and interesting to them.	Title: Bowling Materials: Recyclable bottles and a soft ball Directions: Arrange recyclable bottles on the floor with your child's help. Using a soft ball or toy, knock the bottles down. Count how many fell, and how many are still standing. Ask your child which number is greater or less.
Yellow Light purposeful activities spread throughout the day <u>ABCmouse</u> (use code SCHOOL1446)	Have children count their toys as they are cleaning during the day, At least 3-5 toys and putting them in a basket or box.	During story time throughout the day when reading stories to children, parent should ask open-ended questions about what's happening in the book, characters, what will happen next, etc....	Have children help you set up the table for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. They could count napkins, spoons, and forks.	Activity: Singing songs Materials Needed: YouTube videos, radio (optional) Throughout the day sing songs. For example: ABC's, Months of the year", "Good morning everybody how are you", "Baby shark" etc.	While outside challenge your child to see how many balls or bean bags your child can throw and make in a bucket/basket. Always make it fun. Let them count how many they made in.
