

Rifle racks are not just a work of art to display your hardware but are a necessary range safety tool providing a single structure securing long barreled weapons and ammunition. In ranges without rifle racks, long barreled weapons can be seen propped against the wall or laying on a table or floor creating an unsafe shooting environment.

The average law enforcement officer qualifying on the firing range will normally bring in four weapons, a shotgun, carbine and two pistols. Tactical officers will have an additional number of specialized weapons beyond standard duty requirements requiring qualification. The two PSTC rifle racks provide a safe and secure method for both storing and easy transport of equipment around the range.





The rifle racks are made with heavy duty powder coated steel, each capable of securely holding 20 rifles or shotguns. The glossy blue powder coating on the surface protects the weapons from metal to metal contact and damage. Each rack also has a lower and upper shelf which is capable of holding 50 lbs. of ammunition or training equipment. The locking wheels provide easy rack mobility and convenience down range.

The quality and ruggedness of these racks is recognized and admired by our colleagues. Numerous agency range masters have measured and taken photos of the PSTC racks. They are another example of the quality and expertise on display of the ACC Welding Department.
