# HB 234: Anti-Human Trafficking Protective Response Act

A bill has been filed in the Georgia House of Representatives to protect children who have experienced commercial sexual exploitation or sex trafficking. Representative Chuck Efstration, along with the bipartisan support of many others, sponsored this bill to protect youth victims from criminal liability and ensure that they receive trauma-informed services. ### **HB 234 Fast Facts:**

#### PROTECTIVE RESPONSE



- 1. Restricts the charge of prostitution so youth under 18 are not criminally liable for their own exploitation.
- 2. Mandates trauma-informed services for these youth so they can recover.
- 3. Increases penalties for those who benefit from trafficking and exploiting youth.
- 4. Classifies places where trafficking occurs (hotels, residences, etc.) as a public nuisance.
