

Senate changes to the House Budget

HB 2

- A \$2 million GR reduction to Transportation Funding,
- An additional \$450,000 GR for Scholars and Fine Arts Academies,
- \$1.1 million GR for the St. Joseph School District Hillyard Technical Center,

HB 3

- A 3.7% core increase for institutions that are members of COPHE for a total of \$13 million GR
- Community College core increase of \$7 million (\$10 million total)

HB 4

- An additional \$500,000 GR for TIME and AIM zones,
- \$25,000,000 GR total for the road Cost-Share Program
- An additional \$2.8 million GR for Amtrak services
- An additional \$6.3 million GR for Port Authority Capital Improvements

HB 5

- \$27 million federal funds for a Motor Vehicle License System Technology upgrade
- An additional \$4 million GR for state parks debt service
- An additional \$100,000 of GR for the regional planning commission

HB 6

- An additional \$5 million GR for the acquisition and donation of land
- An additional \$20 million CARES Act funding for Meat Processing grants
- \$200,000 GR for Urban farming grants

HB 7

- \$150,000,000 Fed Stimulus for MHDC for Homeowner Housing Assistance

HB 8

- \$1 million GR for rapid DNA testing machines to clear the background of untested rape kits
- \$750,000 GR for Volunteer Firefighters Workers Compensation Premiums
- \$7 million CARES ACT for Veterans Homes

HB 9

- an additional \$15,007 for a DOC recruitment plan position
- an additional \$298,166 GR for Correction staff
- an additional \$339,851 GR for the KC Re-entry program

HB 10

- The creation of a Department Deputy Director for Health and Senior Services

HB 11

- \$88 million in GR and Title XIX funds for funding long-term care services in nursing facilities under the MO HealthNet fee-for-services program and for contracted services to develop model policies and practices that improve quality of life for long-term care residents.
