

Fall Bazaar 2022 FAQs:

- 1) What is the Fall Bazaar?
 - The St. Anne Community Fall Bazaar is the largest community-wide (Church AND School) annual fundraising event. Its purpose is to unite our entire community for a day of faith, fun and fellowship while also providing some much-needed financial assistance to both our church and school.
- 2) What is the date of the 2022 Fall Bazaar?
 - Sunday, October 23, 2022
- 3) What time is the Fall Bazaar?
 - The bazaar will begin immediately following the 10:00AM mass (probably around 11:30AM) and will end at 5:00PM.
- 4) What will the 2022 Fall Bazaar look like this year?
 - The 2022 Fall Bazaar will have fun for the entire family. From carnival games, field games and activities like face painting and balloon creations to adult friendly games and BINGO, there is plenty to keep you busy for the afternoon.
 - Come HUNGRY! We will offer a wide range of foods like the famous Knights of Columbus BBQ sandwiches to Hamburgers, Tacos, Elotes and Aguas Frescas to Cajun Cuisine like Gumbo and Jambalaya to delicious Marco's Pizza to Nachos, Hotdogs, Frito Chili Pie, Popcorn, Marty's Sweet Shop and more....
 - Like Shopping? Stroll through our Silent Auction and the St. Anne Craft Booth in the gymnasium – open from 11:30AM – 3:00PM. Want to take it up a notch? Stick around for our LIVE Auction that will begin at 3:30PM.
 - Grab your raffle tickets and enter to win one of our FIVE incredible raffle prizes. Winners will be drawn immediately following the LIVE Auction around 4:30PM.
- 5) Where will the 2022 Fall Bazaar take place?
 - The 2022 Fall Bazaar will take place inside the gymnasium as well as in the parking lot between the gymnasium and St. Anne Catholic School and into the field on the far north side of the parking lot.
- 6) What is the theme for the 2022 Fall Bazaar?
 - Our theme this year is: "Fall Into Christ. He Never Leaves."
- 7) Is there a Bazaar website?
 - We are working on a website (thanks to Tom Devore) that will host the essential information as well as provide a location to sign up for volunteer opportunities, bazaar events, bidder registration information, etc.

- 8) Who can come to the Fall Bazaar?
 - We invite all of our community to join us! You neither need to be a parishioner nor a school family to attend the Fall Bazaar. All are welcome.
- 9) Is there a cost for entry into the Fall Bazaar?

NO. Entry into the bazaar is FREE. You can come walk around, check out the goodies in the silent and live auctions without requiring any tickets.

10) What will we need to bring to purchase food/games/activities?

- Most of the Fall Bazaar is CASH FREE (outside of BINGO) so we will do a cash-for-ticket exchange at the entry of the Bazaar (in front of St. Vincent de Paul). We will have price lists for all foods/games and activities to give you an idea of how many tickets you may require.
- You can purchase tickets with CASH/CHECK or CARD at the entry of the Bazaar.
- You can repurchase tickets throughout the day if you need to.

11) Can I preorder Tickets to avoid the line on the day of the bazaar?

- Yes. We do plan to offer pre-orders for Fall Bazaar tickets. We will post additional information on the website and have it available after the masses and at the school.
- Pre-ordered tickets will be available at the Will Call table in front of St. Vincent de Paul on the day of Fall Bazaar.

12) Can I get a refund on the tickets I purchased but did not use before leaving the event?

- Unfortunately, NO. We apologize for the inconvenience but we are unable to refund unused tickets.

13) Are you looking for volunteers?

- YES. If you are interested in volunteering in any capacity, we would love your help. We could use help now preparing for the event, we need lots of help setting up on Saturday, October 22 and prior to the bazaar start time on October 23. 14) Can you provide volunteer certificates for service hours?

- YES. We will be able to provide certificates for our volunteers as long as we have record of their hours worked before, during and after the event. We will provide forms for signing in and out each day. You are responsible for making sure you do in fact sign in and out as that is our only means to track volunteer hours. We will get the certificated completed as quickly as possible and expect to have them available for pickup in the church/school office(s) within a week of the bazaar.

15) Do volunteers need any special certifications?

- ALL adult volunteers must be Safe Haven (previously VIRTUS) certified through the Galveston-Houston Archdiocese. Anyone who comes in contact with our youth are required to be certified. - YES. We will have a silent auction with a variety of baskets available at various price ranges.

25) Can I donate an item/basket for the Silent Auction?

- YES. We appreciate donations for the Silent Auction. We will be accepting donations in the church office (and before/after masses) until OCTOBER 19, 2022.

- YES. We will have a LIVE auction on the day of the event. The LIVE Auction is scheduled to begin at 3:30PM outside under the main tent.

30) Can I donate an item for the LIVE Auction?
