Students who are dropped off are to do so in the Acacia parking lot. Students will queue to complete the symptom and temperature check. Face masks MUST be on and worn all day. Students who drive are to park in the student lot. Students will then proceed to the security gate to queue for the symptom and temperature check.

Health & Safety Procedures

While the safety of our community is of primary importance, we also want to best meet the spiritual, academic, social and emotional needs of our students as we continue to provide excellence in Catholic education. Rosary Academy has worked conscientiously to put reopening plans in place designed to protect our students, families, teachers and staff.

HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE

Daily health screening questionnaire and temperature check for all prior to entering campus. Responses will be kept confidential.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Classroom layouts will be modified to maintain physical distancing. Directional signs for flow of pedestrians posted throughout campus.

HAND-WASHING

Hand-washing will be encouraged throughout the day. Students and staff should wash their hands for 20 seconds with soap, rubbing thoroughly after application.

ONGOING SUPPORT

School personnel will be provided ongoing support to ensure effective system wide implementation of health and safety practices.

HAND SANITIZER

Additional hand sanitizing stations have been placed throughout campus including classrooms.

LOCKERS

Lockers will not be issued for the first semester, eliminating gatherings in hallways.

FACE COVERINGS

Face coverings are required for everyone while on the Rosary Academy campus. Masks do not have to be Rosary colors or images, but MUST be appropriate for school. No political statements.

TRAINING

Students and staff will receive training on COVID-19 prevention practices, including hand-washing, physical distancing and face covering use. Signage and ongoing communication will supplement and reinforce training.

NO SUPPLY SHARING

All Rosary personnel and students are discouraged from sharing supplies, books, phones and any other tangible items.

CLEANING

Rosary Academy has been professionally sanitized and disinfected. The school will continue to sanitize and disinfect the facilities each day.

ROYAL RETAIL

To better protect our community, the Royal Retail store will be closed during our Royal Return.

Important Policy Reminders

STUDENT ID'S

At Royal Return, freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will have their picture taken for the yearbook and their student ID. Please dress appropriately. Communication regarding student ID card distribution is to come. Students will receive a Rosary Academy lanyard and their ID card which they will be expected to wear at all times during on campus learning. Students may only wear Rosary Academy lanyards. There is a charge for replacements and can be handled with the Dean of Students.

CELL PHONES & ELECTRONIC WATCHES

Students are allowed to have a cell phone in their possession during the school day. However, during class, or lunch cell phones must not be seen, used, or heard. They must be in their backpack or locker powered OFF. Headphones are not allowed during school hours unless permitted by a faculty or staff member. Students are allowed to wear an electronic watch to school but may be asked to remove it for a quiz or test.

STUDENT PARKING POLICY

All juniors and seniors who intend to drive themselves to school at any point during the 2020-2021 school year must reserve a parking pass via [**online registration**](#). Sophomores cannot drive during the first semester, however may purchase parking passes at the start of the second semester.
