The Summer Reading Program is an annual event held by public libraries across the United States to promote books and reading among children ages 2-17 and adults 18 and over in their community. The Corsicana Public Library encourages everyone to read for pleasure throughout the year.

The 2018 Children's Summer Reading Program theme is "Libraries Rock!" Reading registration for children will be online on the library's website this year as well as in the library. Early registration will begin on June 1st. The Summer Reading Kick-off Party will be on Saturday, June 2nd at the library from 10:00 a.m. until Noon. The children's reading program will continue through Friday, July 27th. The Adult Summer Reading Program will continue through August 31st. Participants can register for their age-appropriate program at any time throughout the duration of the program.

Guidelines for Participation


In order to become an official participant, you must register online or at the public library and pick up a reading log. Participants will record time spent reading or being read to on their reading log. Separate reading logs are available for each of the three reading levels, which are separated by ages 2-6, 7-12 and 13-18. After reaching each level, participants will receive a prize.

The Summer Reading Achievement Party will be held on Saturday, July 28th from 10 a.m. – Noon at Jester Park Pool for all participants who earned a ticket. Reading logs must be turned in no later than **6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 26th** at the library to earn a Pool Party ticket.

As part of this year's reading program, the library offers a number of programs for children of all ages and some that are especially planned for specific age groups.


