Many blood donors know that they are saving three lives with each donation. They're also selfless stewards of something for which there is no substitute: blood. One in three people could require a transfusion during their lifetime. Carter BloodCare believes that community blood donations should benefit local patients and that's why community blood drives are so important.

Carter BloodCare urges eligible blood donors to consider giving two to three times a year. Whole blood can be donated every 56 days. Other types of blood donations can be given more frequently. Remember to eat a nutritious meal and drink plenty of water at least an hour before giving blood. All donors must weigh at least 110 pounds, feel well on the day of donation, and present a government-issued photo ID each time they give blood.

<u>Potential blood donors</u> may volunteer beginning at age 16 with parental consent; 17-year-olds may give independently and there is no upper age limit for donating blood. For more information on donor eligibility and to make an appointment, call 1-800-366-2834 or visit carterbloodcare.org.
