


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 6.6 percent in October 2017, unchanged from a revised 6.6 percent in September 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
