There are approximately 1.3 million people working manufacturing jobs in California.

Total output for manufacturing was \$300 billion in California for 2017.

Manufacturing in California is the 4th largest sector for GDP value.

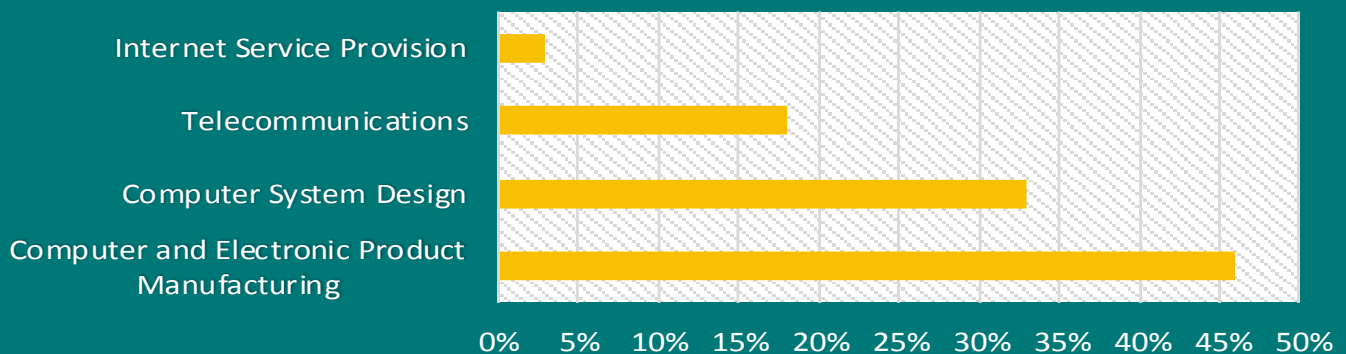
Mexico is California's top export market. Shipments increased by 14% to \$7.68 billion from \$6.4 billion.

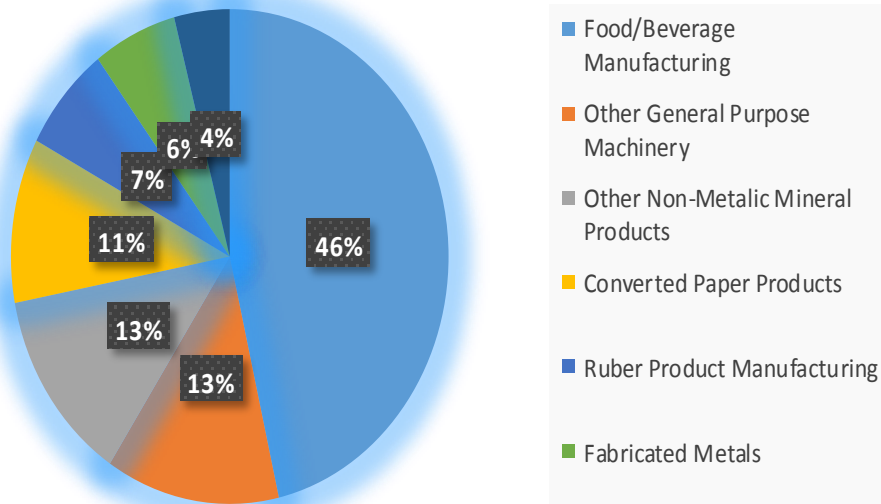
California High-Tech Manufacturing Sectors

The State of Manufacturing in Madera

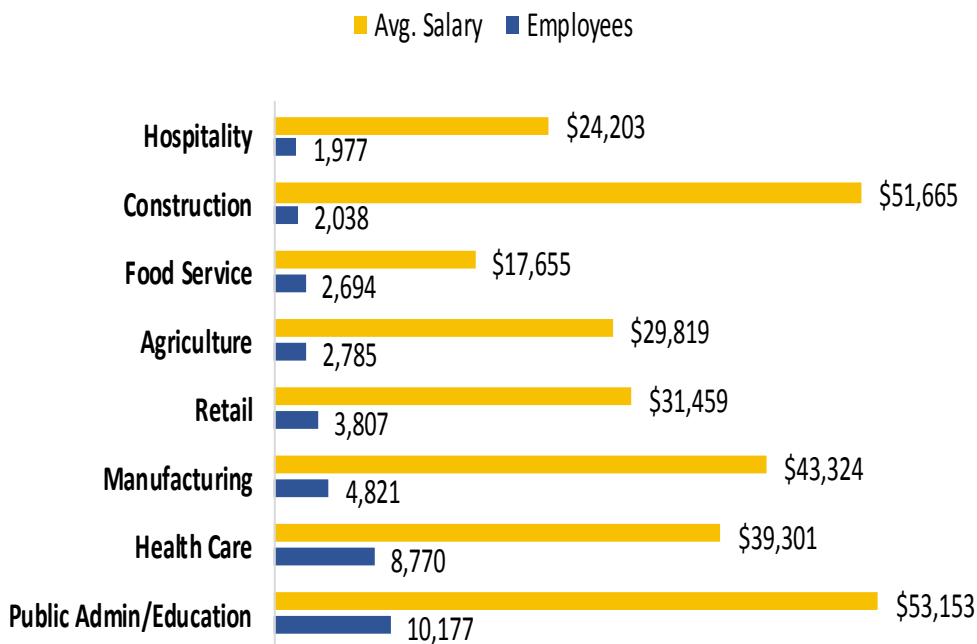
Madera is home to over 100 manufacturing companies and 4,821 manufacturing employees. Constellation Wines is the biggest manufacturing employer in Madera with 400 employees.

Industrial production is projected to increase by 4.1 percent in 2017. From 2017-2022, the growth rate will average 1.9 percent per year.

“Show Me The Money”

Manufacturing is the 3rd biggest industry in Madera with an average annual salary of \$43,324. Only education and the health care sector employs more people.

Average Salary & Number of Employees



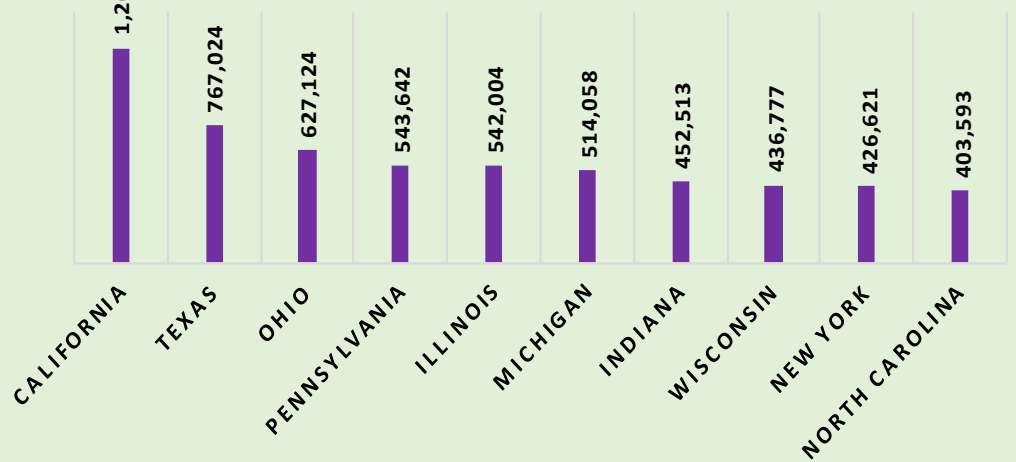
Importance of Manufacturing for the U.S. Economy

Manufacturing is an essential part of any major developed country. In 2018, total GDP has topped \$2.3 trillion dollars; making the U.S. the largest producing country in the world, followed by China.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the U.S. has 12.75 million manufacturing jobs. It is very important for the existence of manufacturing jobs given the fact that it is the biggest sector that employs individuals without a degree.

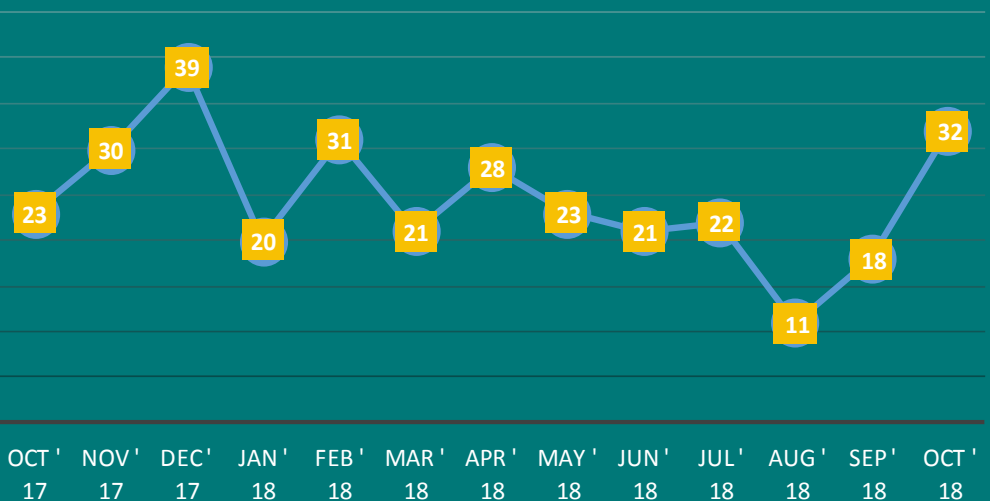
TOP 10 STATES WITH THE MOST MANUFACTURING EMPLOYEES

Hiring Incentives

OJT— The On-The-Job training program enables businesses to hire new employees and receive a reimbursement to offset a portion of the training costs during the training period.

TJT— Transitional Job Training program is a subsidized work-based training activity that takes place at a worksite for a limited period of time.

Tax Credits—Work Opportunity Tax Credit is available for employers who hire individuals who are members of federally designated groups.

PWEX— The Paid Work Experience is a temporary work placement activity in a public, private or non-profit organization. PWEX provides individuals with an opportunity to gain on-the-job knowledge, experience and technical skills, while earning a minimum wage.
