As a grief therapist, Deborah holds her Fellow in Thanatology from the Association for Death Education and Counseling. She is the author of the double award-winning audiobook, Journey Through Pet Loss; and authored a chapter on grief in The Power of Brainspotting: An International Anthology.

She is beginning her PhD on the Visual System, Brainspotting and other modalities utilizing the visual field through the International University for Graduate Studies. Deborah is a masters graduate of NYU's Drama Therapy Dept. Originally an actress, she earned her BFA from the Boston Conservatory of Music and is still in the professional actor's unions, AEA and SAG/AFTRA.
