Cost and other information

Due to the location of EYE20, projected expenses will likely be more than in the past. The Diocese has committed to cover 1/3 of the cost, with the expectation that the delegate's church provide at least 1/3, and participants raise funds for the final 1/3. Early estimates are that the church and delegate portion may total \$1,600 but could be more or less depending on the final number of delegates and post-convention arrangements.
