2019-2020 Scholarship Award

Eligibility Criteria & Scholarship Process

- I. **There are two scholarships available.** Please review the eligibility criteria and select the one(s) for which you are eligible.

Bishop's Scholarship Fund Eligibility criteria:

1. Active baptized members in good standing of an Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Hawai'i as attested by a letter from the congregation's Rector/Vicar/Priest-in-Charge (or Senior/Bishop's Warden if there is no Priest).
2. Entering an Episcopal Church-related school in the Diocese of Hawai'i for the first time (scholarships can be renewed for a second year).
3. Limited to entering kindergarten to grade 12.

The Chang Clergy Children's Scholarship Fund Eligibility criteria:

1. The children of clergy under the age of 24 who are canonically resident and domiciled in the Episcopal Diocese of Hawai'i or the children of deceased clergy who met such criteria at the time of their deaths.
2. Entering pre-school, kindergarten to grade 12 and college/vocational school with preference given in the following order: (1) K to 12, (2) pre-school, and (3) college or vocational school (enrolled full-time). Additional preference is given to students attending schools or colleges related to the Episcopal Church.

- II. **Application Process:** Please provide the following items as one packet.

1. Completed Scholarship Award Application.
2. Letter from a parent/guardian requesting a scholarship.
3. Letter from the child (if entering grade 4 or higher) requesting the scholarship and sharing something about what the child enjoys and hopes for the future.
4. Letter from the student's Priest for the Bishop's Scholarship.
5. Proof of the child's admission to or attendance in a school.
6. A copy of the parents'/guardians' Parents' Financial Statement (PFS), Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or other financial disclosure form for school.

III. Award Process:

1. Scholarships will be awarded by the Bishop in consultation with the President of Standing Committee and/or the Treasurer of the Diocese.
2. Available funds are limited and, therefore, scholarships will likely be limited to \$1,000 per semester for the 2019-2020 school year depending upon the number of applicants and the presenting need.

IV. Award Notification

1. Parents/students will be notified in April.
2. Awards will be mailed directly to the school the student will be entering.
