Lopaka Hoopii and his Ohana, representing Ka Ohana O Kalaupapa, will perform special music, and remind us of the Kalaupapa history and ohana that will endure forever. The emerging Kalaupapa Memorial Project to remember the 8000 patients buried at Kalaupapa, many in unmarked graves, enters the final design and construction phase and is projected to be completed in the summer of 2020.
