INSTRUCTIONAL WORKSHOP

For the **INSTRUCTIONAL WORKSHOP**, FIRST TIME & RETURNING students will have a 4 session workshop. The workshop will be conducted as one class, although individual students may be at different levels of learning and carving. For the instructional workshop, the instructors will be Stephen Fong and Cyrus Won.

FIRST TIME students (4 sessions) (Cost: \$45.00):

This is for an individual who has not taken any prior Narcissus carving class. This will be a hands-on, interactive sessions between the instructor(s) and students. The first session will be to introduce the student to the basic techniques of carving and caring for the narcissus bulb. A handout (which shows the basic technique of carving and caring for the narcissus bulb) and a narcissus bulb will be given to each student on the first day. Tools required are: a carving knife (which will be available for purchase), tweezers, small scissors, cotton balls or pads and a cuticle remover (optional). Also a pen and paper for note taking.

RETURNING students (4 sessions) (Cost: \$35.00):

This is for those who wish to repeat the carving, caring, & presentation techniques of the narcissus bulb. Returning students are requested to bring an already carved bulb on the first day of class. This will be used for a critique/review session.


