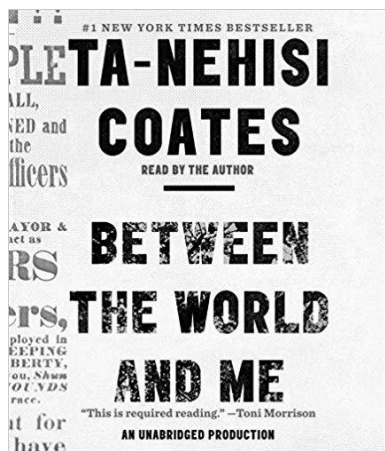


Community Thanksgiving Dinner 2019
