

Materials list for Creative Joy Ride

- The first week DO NOT bring painting supplies, DO bring a note pad and pen or pencil, plus 1 or 2 of your paintings that you are generally pleased with, and 1 or 2 of your works that you feel could have been better.
- Starting the second week and all weeks thereafter bring the same materials you'd bring to any painting class; paints, brushes, palette, medium, reference images, etc.
- Early on, make sure your reference materials are simple compositions; (see examples below) whether they're photos in hard copy or on your tablet or computer.

- During the few weeks you'll need small surfaces in the 6x6" to 12x12" range for quick studies. (I buy 6x6" canvas boards for \$1 or less each in bulk at Jerry's or Blick.)
- During subsequent weeks you can work larger, but not too large, under 16" is best.
- Bring a smallish sketch pad (6x8" to 8x10" range), plus a few of your favorite pencils and an eraser
