## Drawing for the Non-Objective Artist Supply List

Drawing is an important yet overlooked part of Non-Objective painting.

This class aims to allow the student to incorporate drawing techniques onto their painting process. Although classic drawing is suggested, it is a springboard and does not attempt to take the place of a classical drawing program.

### **Supports**

- 1 Large piece of Mixed media paper will be provided by the artist
- 1 book of Strathmore Acrylic paper 12 x 12 preferred Jerry's \$10 (or comparable)
- 1 Strathmore 300 series Bristol Paper 11 x 14 or larger (or comparable)

### **Drawing Material**

Bring what you have and:

vine charcoal and white vinyl eraser

Water soluble pencils (ex: Inktense pencils by Dewert set of 6 \$12)

Any water-soluble color product. *(A small watercolor kit will be provided by the artist)*

ex: a few acrylic colors or petite watercolor pan set about \$7)

### **Brushes**

- 1 liner brush
- 1 small wash brush
- 1 medium palette knife

### **Additional materials**

Paper Towels

1 small gel medium

Scissors

Artist Tape 2"tape

Container for water
