A workshop introducing cold wax medium and many of the techniques for painting and mixed media work. We will cover all the basics so that you will understand how and, more importantly why, you might incorporate using cold wax medium into your artistic practice. Get basic training, including using the materials safely and efficiently and have some fun exploring this revitalized medium.

Materials:

Palette Paper

Oil paints

Cold wax medium

Odorless mineral spirits- (Gamsol first choice)

Braced or unbraced panels (1/4" birch first choice)

Arches oil paper

Tools and supplies:

Brayers, scrapers
Silicone tools (Catalyst first choice)
Silicone pastry bowl scraper (Messermeister first choice)
Palette knives
Masking tape
Paper towels
Trash bags

Optional materials:

mark-makers (ArtGraf discs, pencils,)
PanPastel
photo reprints to transfer/embed
fabrics like lace or netting
tissue paper to embed
onion bags or textures
papers to collage
foils or transfer paper
stamps or pattern rollers
