

Pick Up Take-Out, Stay and Have a Picnic in the Burleigh Café, or Enjoy Full Service Dining Inside

It's been long 13 weeks since the Providence Art Club was open for in-door dining. Boy, did we miss you. Starting Monday, June 15, members will have 3 options of dining.

1. Traditional take-out ([email Alda](#) with your choices)
2. Picnic (traditional take-out, [email Alda](#) with your choices and reserve an outdoor table, limited staff interaction)
3. Old Fashion Full Service dining (with restrictions). **Reservations are required.** Contact information for your guests is also required.

We're going to remain vigilant with our safety procedures. Masks are required to enter the Club. Staff will take your temperature. For everyone's safety, we ask that anyone who is feeling the slightest bit ill to stay home. All bathrooms will be open and sanitized frequently.

For in-door dining, disposable menus will be available or you can access the menu through our daily email. Staff will change gloves between tables, and wear masks.

Reservations

Reservations are required and will be offered on a first come-first served basis. Please email reservations@providenceartclub.org or call the Club for reservations at 401.331.1114 x 3. Due to limited seating and in consideration of your fellow members, please cancel any reservation promptly. Reservations are allowed for groups up to five. Walk-ins are not permitted. In order to adhere to contact tracing protocols, please include the name and contact information of your dining guests, even if this is a family member.

Burleigh Café Dining

Please enter the Burleigh Café from the parking lot entrance. Along with tables set in the Burleigh Cafe, we will also have tables available on the 3rd floor terrace deck (off the Masiello Studio). When you place your order/reservation with Alda, please remind us of any dietary restrictions you or your guest/s may have. Chef Drew and his team continue to create a wonderful menu and offer daily specials.

Inclement Weather

Seb will keep an eye on the weather. Should the decision be made to close or delay outdoor dining, we will reach out via email or telephone.

Concerns about the Coronavirus

Our top priority is the safety, health, and well being of our staff and members! Please know that we are taking every measure to ensure your safety while dining at the Art Club. No one is allowed to dine or enter the Club with a fever or if they do not feel 100%. Please wear a facemask during your visit.

Tables will be spaced 8 feet apart according to Rhode Island regulations and social distancing. Tables will be wiped down and sanitized with every table turn over. A trash receptacle will be available so members may discard their own trash. Alcohol or any items from the bar must be pre-ordered with lunch. Plastic cups and plastic utensils will be provided when you indicate that you would like to stay on premise for picnic dining. A staff member will take your temperature when you walk on premise. The only restrooms available will be the two in the Dodge House Gallery and will be sanitized quite often during lunch service.

The Art of Take-Out

The Art of Take-Out will continue at this time. Pre-order is required. Check your email daily for the menu of the day. Email Alda at reservations@providenceartclub.org up until 12pm the day of your order with your selection, along with the time between the hours of 12pm-2:30pm you'd like to pick it up.
