



Process for Qualifying for the 2020 Cal Cup Team

The LPGA Amateur Cal Cup Tournament is held annually in the month of May. It is a two-day match play tournament playing Foursome, Fourball and Individual formats. Due to registration deadlines and sufficient time for the team to practice, the team is identified in November of the year prior to the event.

Qualifying Process

Keeping in mind that Cal Cup team members are representatives of our Sacramento Chapter, participation in eligible chapter events is an important component in making the team. In support of this belief, qualifying for the team is based on the achievement of participation points to identify six team members and one qualifying event to identify five members. The 12th member of the team is reserved for a captain's pick.

Events qualifying for participation points are outlined on the following pages. Points are awarded for participation in events that educate and support skills acquisition for competitive play.

Cal Cup Selection Information and Criteria

Cal Cup Chapter Qualifier: November 10, 2019
Location: Timber Creek Golf Course
Team Composition: 12 players

Participant's Financial Obligations – Participants should expect to spend approximately \$1,000-1,500 for the Cal Cup weekend of events.

Selection Criteria Waiver – At the Board's discretion, the active participation criteria may be waived upon request, if a member has a medical condition, such as injury or surgery, which has precluded her from actively participating in the required number of events.

Qualifying Information

Handicaps

- Per Cal Cup policy, the maximum allowable handicap index for a team member is 32. If a team member's handicap exceeds 32, she must play to the maximum 32.

Active Chapter Participation

- Must have earned a minimum of 10 participation points from eligible events.

Team Selection

Two ways to qualify for the team:

- Earn qualifying event points during the season (based on 2019 participation in eligible events, including leagues, and LPGA Amateurs organized monthly play, as well as some educational sessions) to acquire one of the six open team positions; OR
- Compete in the Cal Cup Qualifier for one of the five open team positions (must meet "active" criteria of a minimum of 10 qualifying participation points)

Players will be selected as follows:

- Six (6) from event point totals (opportunity to join the Cal Cup team starts with the member accumulating the greatest number of participation points and continues down the list until the maximum six have accepted)
- Five (5) from Cal Cup Qualifier to be scheduled November 2019 (interested members who achieved the minimum 10 participation points but not in the top six positions are eligible to compete in the one-day qualifier). Two low gross and three low net will be offered a position on the team.
- One (1) Captain's pick (Captain can select any Sacramento LPGA member who achieved a minimum of 10 qualifying participation points)
