Lucky 7-7-7 Series

We are now set to kickoff the 2026 golf season! This document is designed to provide information regarding our new three part golf series and your opportunity to win valuable prizes while enjoying golf with friends.

DESCRIPTION

Each Series includes 7 scheduled play dates. Formats and courses will vary. Events will include singles, partner, and team formats. In addition, EVERY event offers the potential to score points based on individual play and all important net birdies. Participants earn between 1 and 3 points based on results of play at any event designated as a “points” event. Explanation of how points are accumulated will be distributed prior to play at event.

- ACS = Arcade Creek Series (April 4 thru May 24)
- SRS = Sacramento River Series (May 30 thru Aug 9)
- LNS = Lake Natomas Series (Aug 22 thru Oct 18)

FLIGHTS

Players will be split into two flights. (**Note: Members without a handicap may participate in events, however, handicaps will be required to earn leaderboard points for prizes.**)

Flights for the **ACS** will be as follows:

- **Flight A:** All competitors with a handicap index of 21.9 and lower.
- **Flight B:** All competitors with a handicap index of 22.0 and higher.

(Flight assignment will be based on handicap index as of **April 1**. Once assigned to a Flight the competitor will remain in that Flight for the duration of the current Series regardless of fluctuations in handicap.)

NOTE: The Flight midpoint of the SRS series will be determined based on the median index for those who participated in the ACS. SRS handicap index will be determined as of **May 25**. The Flight midpoint of the LNS series will be determined based on the median index for those who participated in the SRS. LNS handicap index will be determined as of **August 15**.

SCORING

A leaderboard will be updated and posted on our website following each event. Prizes will be awarded to the top 10 finalist in each flight. Players final score for each Series will be the best 6 scores of the potential 7 dates. The lowest score will be dropped. **NOTE:** if one or more dates are cancelled due to weather or other events, all remaining rounds in the series will be used for final total score.

If this sounds confusing...don't worry! We do all the set-up, calculations, and leaderboard updates.
You simply sign up, show up and play golf. The best way to figure it all out is to jump in and play!

Events scheduled outside of "Series" scoring include preseason, and:

May 16 - Two person scramble (fundraiser for LPGA Girls Golf)

July 5 - Two person challenge

Aug 30 – Four person team scramble (Fundraiser for LPGA Girls Golf)

Nov 15 -- Two person Chapman format (Turkey Hunt)

Play is open to all members. Jump in and have fun in 2026.
