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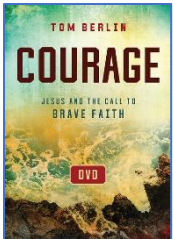
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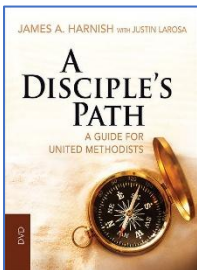

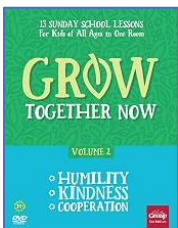
ANIMATE: FAITH (101098) A seven-session DVD study on faith. Session titles and presenters: 1) God - Faith is a quest / Brian McLaren (10 min.); 2) Religion - Spirituality is not enough / Lillian Daniel (8 min.); 3) Jesus - The revolution of love / Mark Scandrette (9 min.); 4) Salvation - Abundant life now / Shane Hipps (9 min.); 5) Cross - Where God is / Nadia Bolz-Weber (8 min.); 6) Bible - A book like no other / Lauren Winner (8 min.); 7) Church - An imperfect family / Bruce Reyes-Chow (8 min.). Includes facilitator guide and sample journal. Age: Adult. 60 Minutes.



COURAGE: JESUS AND THE CALL TO BRAVE FAITH (103156) Author: Berlin, Tom. In this six-session DVD study, Tom Berlin explores the composition of what we call courage, with Jesus as our guide and our focus. Sessions: 1) The clarity of courage (9 min.); 2) The conviction of courage (7 min.); 3) The candor of courage (8 min.); 4) The hope of courage (7 min.); 5) The fortitude of courage (7 min.); 6) The love of courage (7 min.). Includes leader's guide and paperback book. CLOSED CAPTIONED. Age: Adult. 45 Minutes.



DISCIPLE'S PATH: A GUIDE FOR UNITED METHODISTS (104099) Author: Harnish, James A. and LaRosa, Justin. This six-session DVD study is an engaging approach to discipleship from a distinctly Wesleyan perspective. Whether used as an introduction for new members or a renewal course for existing members, this study guides individuals to take the next step in discipleship and become dynamic, engaged followers of Jesus Christ. Sessions: 1) A disciple's path defined (10 min.); 2) Prayers (10 min.); 3) Presence (10 min.); 4) Gifts (10 min.); 5) Service (10 min.); 6) Witness (10 min.). GROW TOGETHER NOW: VOLUME 2 -- HUMILITY, KINDNESS, COOPERATION (107113) Author: Brolsma, Jody, editor. 13 Sunday School Lessons for Kids of All Ages in One Room. This book and accompanying DVD includes plans for 13 lessons on humility (seeing myself the way God sees me), kindness (treating others as beloved creations of God), and cooperation (working together to accomplish a goal). DVD segments are 2-5 minutes long -- three lessons (#1, #7, and #12) do not have a DVD component. 30 Minutes.

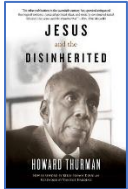

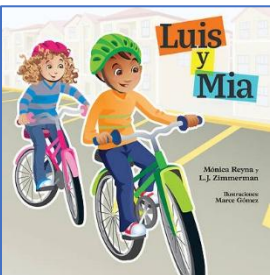

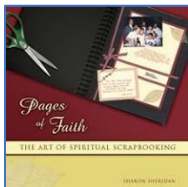


JESUS AND THE DISINHERITED (817179) Author: Thurman, Howard. First published in 1949, this book is a compassionate look at God's work in our lives. As we struggle today with issues of poverty, racism, and spiritual disengagement, Howard Thurman's discerning reading of the message of renewal through self-love as exemplified in the life of Jesus resonates powerfully once again. Chapters: Jesus - an interpretation; Fear; Deception; Hate; Love. Age: Adult. 102 Pages.

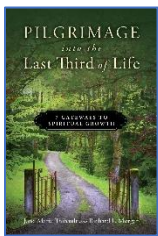


LUIS Y MIA/MIA AND LUIS (818148) Author: Reyna, Monica and Zimmerman, L.J. This paperback book for children is a flip-over book that tells the story of a cross-cultural friendship from each child's perspective. Luis is the child of Mexican immigrants and Mia is a White American child. Their story begins when Mia makes a culturally insensitive remark to Luis. Prayer and thoughtful conversations with family help Luis and Mia move past this rocky start and develop a lasting friendship. Mia's story explores important issues such as what makes someone American, biblical perspectives on immigrants, and how to make amends. Luis's story explores issues such as cultural pride, challenges faced by immigrants, and forgiveness. This book, with

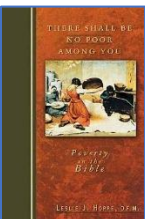
both English and Spanish text, will help children ages 6-9 understand the importance of showing love to people who are different, apologizing when you're wrong, forgiving one another, and making everyone feel welcome. Age: Elementary. 60 Pages.



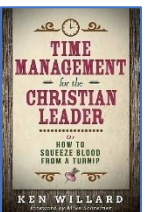
PAGES OF FAITH: THE ART OF SPIRITUAL SCRAPBOOKING (807178) Author: Sheridan, Sharon. In stories and pictures, this book shows how Christians tell the stories of their faith in the pages of their scrapbooks. It includes ideas for using scrapbooking as a teaching tool with children, guidelines for forming a scrapbook club, and using scrapbooking to tell the story of your church and its ministries. Age: Adult. 133 Pages.



PILGRIMAGE INTO THE LAST THIRD OF LIFE: SEVEN GATEWAYS TO SPIRITUAL GROWTH (814099) Author: Thibault, Jane Marie and Morgan, Richard. The Last Third of life (age 60 and beyond) offers significant challenges that the authors suggest we approach as a pilgrimage. Their brief, scripture-based meditations and reflections examine seven tasks essential to living the Last Third fearlessly and with purpose: 1) Facing aging and dying; 2) Living with limitations; 3) Doing inner work; 4) Living in and out of community; 5) Prayer and contemplation; 6) Redeeming loss and suffering; 7) Leaving a legacy. THERE SHALL BE NO POOR AMONG YOU: POVERTY IN THE BIBLE (815095) Author: Hoppe, Leslie. Dealing with the motifs of the poor and poverty that occur throughout the Bible, the purpose of this book is to determine how the Bible can help individual believers and communities of faith shape their response to the poor and poverty today. Chapters: The Torah; The Former Prophets; The Latter Prophets; Wisdom Literature; The Psalms; Apocalyptic Literature; The New Testament; The Rabbinic Tradition. Includes bibliography and Scripture index. Age: Adult. 197 Pages.
