DVD studies:

24 HOURS THAT CHANGED THE WORLD (120032) Author: Hamilton, Adam. This seven-session DVD study will help you better understand the events that occurred during the last 24 hours of Jesus' life; to see more clearly the theological significance of Christ's suffering and death; and to reflect upon the meaning of these events for your life. DVD segments: Introduction (1 min.); 1) The Last Supper (11 min.); 2) The Garden of Gethsemane (7 min.); 3) Condemned by the Righteous (9 min.); 4) Jesus, Barabbas, and Pilate (9 min.); 5) The Torture and Humiliation of the King (9 min.); 6) The Crucifixion (13 min.); 7) Christ the Victor (11 min.); Bonus: What If Judas Had Lived? (5 min.). Includes leader's guide and hardback book. Age: Adult. 77 Minutes

CASE FOR EASTER (103149) Author: Strobel, Lee. In this four-session DVD study, Lee Strobel reveals what he discovered as he went through the evidence of the empty tomb, inviting you to examine the evidence for yourself and consider why Easter is so important to your faith. (105029) This six-session DVD small group Bible study for adults (and mature teens) brings the passion and resurrection of Jesus to life through dramatic (and graphic) storytelling and challenging teaching done in a highly cinematic style. Sessions: 1) My life has a purpose; 2) My life can change; 3) My pain is understood; 4) My life has a plan; 5) I have the promise of eternal life; 6) My hope is secure. FINAL WORDS FROM THE CROSS (106041) Author: Hamilton, Adam. In this six-session DVD study appropriate for Lent or any time of year, Barb Roose explores chapters in the Psalms that identify a Savior, a Messiah, or a coming King. GOD WE CAN KNOW: EXPLORING THE 'I AM' SAYINGS OF JESUS (107081) Author: Fuquay, Rob. In this seven-session DVD study, travel to the Holy Land with Rob Fuquay and see the places where Jesus stood as he made his 'I Am' declarations. This study will help you experience Jesus anew and discover the God who wants to be known. GRACE OF LES MISERABLES (107119) Author: Rawle, Matt. Victor Hugo's 'Les Miserables' is a truly epic story. Whether you've read the novel, seen the Broadway musical, heard its soundtrack, or seen the several screen adaptations, you already know the power in the story. This six-session DVD study with Matt Rawle, appropriate for use during Lent or any time of year, dives into six ideals found in the story — grace, justice, poverty, revolution, love, and hope — each represented by a character in Hugo's story. Sessions: 1) Grace well received -- Valjean (12 min.); 2) When grace and justice collide -- Javert (10 min.); 3) The poor are always with you -- Fantine (10 min.); 4) The gift of love -- Marius and Cosette (11 min.); 5) Building the barricade -- Les Amis (10 min.); 6) The blessed garden -- a hopeful vision (10 min.). GREAT REVERSAL: THE LIFE AND DEATH AND LIFE OF JESUS (107099) Author: LeRoy, Matt. A nine-week journey through the Gospel of John. Sessions: 1) John 1 - the new creation story (11 min.); 2) John 2-3 -- the new way (12 min.); 3) John 4 -- the water of life (20 min.); 4) John 5-6 -- miracles (9 min.); 5) John 7-10 -- authority (15 min.); 6) John 11-12 -- the beginning of the end (21 min.); 7) John 13-17 -- last words (11 min.); 8) John 18-19 -- it is finished (9 min.); 9) John 20-21 -- the pioneer (12 min.). HE CHOSE THE NAILS (108061) Author: Lucado, Max. In this five-session DVD study, Max Lucado explores the many gifts that Christ provided to us at his crucifixion. Sessions: 1) He chose to be one of us (15 min.); 2) He chose to forgive us (16 min.); 3) He chose to invite us into His presence (15 min.); 4) He chose to love us forever (16 min.); 5) He chose to give us victory (18 min.). IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE SAVIOR: FOLLOWING JESUS THROUGH THE HOLY LAND (109070) Author: Lucado, Max. In this six-session DVD study filmed in the Holy Land, we come alongside bestselling author and pastor Max Lucado as he shares key teachings from the Gospels and Acts on the people and places that shaped Jesus' life. While helping us learn more about Jesus, Max also encourages us to grow in our faith. Sessions: 1) Capernaum - following Jesus when you doubt (20 min.); 2) Sea of Galilee - following Jesus in your storms (20 min.); 3) Mount of Beatitudes -- following Jesus when you worry (21 min.); 4) Temple steps - following Jesus . . . and only Jesus (20 min.); 5) Garden Tomb - following Jesus when you need hope (20 min.); 6) Caesarea by the Sea - following Jesus when you need grace (21 min.). JOHN: THE GOSPEL OF LIGHT AND LIFE (110049) Author: Hamilton, Adam. In this six-session DVD study, Adam Hamilton explores the major themes of the Gospel of John. Sessions: 1) The Word made flesh (13 min.); 2) The miraculous signs of Jesus (15 min.); 3) The 'I AM' sayings of Jesus (17 min.); 4) The farewell discourse (12 min.); 5) The arrest, trial, and crucifixion of the King (14 min.); 6) Eternal life (16 min.). LAST DAYS OF JESUS (112056) Six In-Depth DVD Studies Connecting the Bible to Life. LAST SUPPER ON THE MOON: THE OCEAN OF SPACE, THE MYSTERY OF GRACE, AND THE LIFE JESUS DIED FOR YOU TO HAVE (112137) Author: Lusko, Levi. In this five-session DVD study, author and pastor Levi Lusko journeys back in time and forward in hope, using the 1969 lunar mission as an analogy of the metamorphosis that was unleashed by the man from Galilee. Along the way, he uncovers the remarkable "seven statements" that Jesus made from the cross - words that provide us everything we need in the chaos of our world to conquer judgment, persecution, anxiety, and pain. Sessions: 1) Crisis in the skies (21 min.); 2) Prepare for lift off (21 min.); 3) Obstacles in orbit (19 min.); 4) Mission accomplished (21 min.); 5) The journey home (21 min.). Includes study guide (with leader notes) and hardback book. CLOSED CAPTIONED. Age: Adult. 103 Minutes

LUKE: JESUS AND THE OUTSIDERS, OUTCASTS, AND OUTLAWS (112138) Author: Hamilton, Adam. In this six-session DVD study, Adam Hamilton explores the life, teachings, death, and resurrection of Jesus as told in the Gospel of Luke. Through Luke's stories we find Jesus' care and compassion for all as he welcomes sinners and outcasts. As we study Luke and see Jesus' concern for those who were considered unimportant, we hear a hopeful and inspiring word for our lives today. Sessions: 1) Lifting up the lowly (12 min.); 2) Simon, do you see this woman (12 min.); 3) Parables from the underside (12 min.); 4) On the journey to Jerusalem (11 min.); 5) The final week (12 min.); 6) Crucified with the outlaws (13 min.). PASSION NARRATIVES (116073) Author: Eford, James 'Mickey'. This 18-session study examines the passion narratives in the gospels of Mark, Luke, Matthew, and John. DVD segments vary from 12-23 minutes in length. Includes sample participant workbook. Age: Adult. 338 Minutes.

PASSION OF CHRIST (116032) Author: Rolheiser, Ron. Through Scripture and examples from life, Fr. Ron Rolheiser gives new insight into Jesus' passion and what it has to teach us as Christians. Part 1: The Passion of Christ refers to Jesus' passivity, not to his physical suffering and death. After a life of activity, now Jesus is passive and things are done to him. In what way does this change or deepen my understanding of Jesus and his passion? How do I react when I feel powerless? How can I live so that my death can be a blessing for my family and friends? (40 min.). Part 2: In the Agony in the Garden, Jesus was "a stone's throw away" from his disciples. That is, he was experiencing that loneliness in which the deepest part of us is alone. What in my life helps me to understand him in this experience? (49 min.). Includes guide. Age: Adult. 89 Minutes.

PASSION PLAY: LIVING THE STORY OF CHRIST'S LAST DAYS (116110) Author: Fuquay, Rob. Jesus' Passion story is presented each Lent in countless churches every year. But one play presented by the inhabitants of the village of Oberammergau, in Bavaria, Germany, may be one of the longest-running performance of all. Staged every ten years since 1634, the play makes an impact not only on the villagers who portray the characters but on all who see it as well. In this six-session DVD study, which was filmed on location in Germany and contains behind-the-scenes footage of the production, Rob Fuquay follows the biblical story of the Passion and shows how this amazing play has been used both as a ritual of praise and later as a weapon through its anti-Semitic past. Sessions: 1) The power of a vow (8 min.); 2) The importance of community (7 min.); 3) The role of ritual (6 min.); 4) Living the story (8 min.); 5) Telling a better story (9 min.); 6) The power of the cross (8 min.). PATH TO THE CROSS (116055) Author: Vander Laan, Ray. FAITH LESSONS Volume 11. Discover how the passionate faith of God's people prepares the way for Jesus and his ultimate act of obedience and sacrifice at the cross. Then, be challenged in your own life to live as they did -- by every word that comes from the mouth of God. Five lessons: 1) The Way of the Essenes (Qumran), 29 min.; 2) The Way of John the Baptist (Machaerus), 29 min.; 3) Into the Desert to Be Tested (En Gedi), 30 min.; 4) The Last Passover (Jerusalem), 32 min.; 5) The Fifth Cup -- Our Way of Hope (Gethsemane), 29 min. RENEGADE GOSPEL: THE REBEL JESUS (118060) Author: Slaughter, Mike. In this six-session DVD study, Mike Slaughter invites us to replace our version of a benign, Sunday school Jesus with the rebel Jesus, who came to initiate a revolutionary movement to bring God's kingdom into the world. We are encouraged to consider what it means to follow Him and what the true cost of discipleship is. Sessions: 1) Discovering the rebel Jesus; 2) Revolutionary lifestyle; 3) The most important question you will ever have to answer; 4) Seeing Jesus today; 5) The way of the cross; 6) Resurrection. DVD segments are 10 minutes long. Includes leader's guide and paperback book. CLOSED CAPTIONED. Age: High school - Adult. 59 Minutes.

SAVIOR: WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT THE CROSS (119182) Author: deVega, Magrey. In this six-session DVD study, Magrey deVega guides us through various meanings of Jesus's death and resurrection. By exploring the mystery of salvation through the cross, we can deepen our love for God and others and strengthen our commitment to follow Jesus. Sessions: 1) Substitution - Jesus takes your place (11 min.); 2) Ransom - Jesus sets you free (9 min.); 3) Moral example - Jesus shows you how to live (8 min.); 4) Reconciliation - Jesus restores your relationship (9 min.); 5) Cleansing - Jesus makes you clean (8 min.); 6) Christus victor - Jesus gives you the victory (9 min.). Includes leader's guide and paperback book. CLOSED CAPTIONED. Age: Adult. 54 Minutes.

SEVEN WORDS: LISTENING TO CHRIST FROM THE CROSS (119183) Author: Robb, Susan. In this six-session DVD study, Susan Robb looks at the seven last words of Christ on the cross through a lens that finds life and hope in his final sayings, while exploring each from a biblical and historical perspective. Sessions: 1) Father, forgive them (11 min.); 2) Today you will be with me in paradise (10 min.); 3) My God, My God (11 min.); 4) Woman, here is your son (9 min.); 5) I am thirsty (10 min.); 6) Into your hands (10 min.). Includes leader's guide and paperback book. CLOSED CAPTIONED. Age: Adult. 61 Minutes.

SIMON PETER: FLAWED BUT FAITHFUL DISCIPLE (119167) Author: Hamilton, Adam. This six-session DVD study features Adam Hamilton on location in Israel and Italy showing key sites in the life of Simon Peter and exploring the life, faith, and character of Simon Peter. Sessions: 1) The call of the fisherman (17 min.); 2) Walking with Jesus in the storms (12 min.); 3) Bedrock or stumbling block? (16 min.); 4) 'I will not deny you' (19 min.); 5) From cowardice to courage (18 min.); 6) The rest of the story (18 min.). Includes leader's guide and hardback book. CLOSED CAPTIONED. STORY OF JESUS (119142) Author: Frazee, Randy. This seven-session DVD study presented by Randy Frazee provides individuals and small groups the opportunity to learn, discuss, and apply Jesus' life, work and teachings to their lives. Sessions: 1) The birth of the King (13 min.); 2) Jesus' ministry begins (12 min.); 3) No ordinary man (11 min.); 4) Jesus, the Son of God (11 min.); 5) The hour of darkness (12 min.); 6) The resurrection (10 min.); 7) New beginnings (11 min.). Includes guide. Age: High school - Adult. 80 Minutes.

WALK: FIVE ESSENTIAL PRACTICES OF THE CHRISTIAN LIFE (123116) Author: Hamilton, Adam. In this six-session DVD study, Adam Hamilton focuses on five essential spiritual practices that are rooted in Jesus' own walk with God and taught throughout the New Testament. The last session explores the connection between Jesus' last words from the cross and the five essential Christian practices. Sessions: 1) Worship and prayer - a living hallelujah (14 min.); 2) Study - the importance of listening and paying attention (13 min.); 3) Serve - Here I am Lord, send me (13 min.); 4) Give - where your treasure is . . . 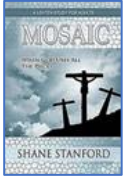

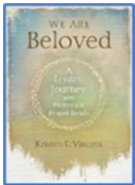
