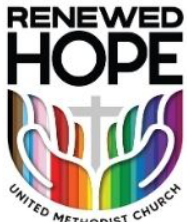

The Renewed Hope Colloquium is a series of engaging presentations to promote conversations around inclusion and justice-making strategies on issues including racism, ableism, ageism, xenophobia and transphobia. This is the third year of the series that has featured presentations by Rev. Martin Deppe, author of "Operation Breadbasket" who shared his historic perspective on the role of faith communities in the civil rights struggle; David Foster, author of "Sermon in Stone" the story of the Chicago Temple; and Rebekah Coffman, curator of Religion and Community History at the Chicago History Museum, speaking on "Sacred Spaces". The Colloquium also organizes field trips such as a tour of the North Lawndale neighborhood with Chicago Mahogany in 2025. Renewed Hope UMC is located at the Albany Park Ministry Center at 3100 W. Wilson Avenue, part of Church Properties Reimagined.
