







## DIFFICULT WORDS OF JESUS: A BEGINNER'S GUIDE TO HIS MOST PERPLEXING

**TEACHINGS (104106)** Author: Levine, Amy-Jill. Jesus provided his disciples teachings for how to follow Torah, God's word; he told them parables to help them discern questions of ethics and of human nature; he offered them beatitudes for comfort and encouragement. But sometimes Jesus spoke words that followers then and now have found difficult. He instructs disciples to hate members of their own families (Luke 14:26), to act as if they were slaves (Matthew 20:27), and to sell their belongings and give to the poor (Luke 18:22). He restricts his mission (Matthew 10:6); he speaks of damnation (Matthew 8:12); he calls Jews the devil's children (John 8:44). In this six-session DVD study, Amy-Jill Levine shows how these difficult teachings would have sounded to the people who first heard them, how they have been understood over time, and how we might interpret them in the context of the Gospel of love and reconciliation. Sessions: 1) Sell what you own (13 min.); 2) Hate father and mother (13 min.); 3) Slave of all (13 min.); 4) Nowhere among the Gentiles (14 min.); 5) Outer darkness (12 min.); 6) Your father the devil (12 min.). Includes leader's guide and paperback book. **CLOSED CAPTIONED.** Age: Adult. 77 Minutes.




**EPIC OF EDEN: PSALMS (105098)** Author: Richter, Sandra. The book of Psalms is well-known and well-worn. It is the Old Testament book most often quoted in the New Testament, and its quotations can be found everywhere from John Milton to Star Trek to Congressional speeches. Why so much attention? The Church Father Athanasius said it best--most of Scripture speaks to us, but the Book of Psalms speaks for us. Experience fresh connections to contemporary worship and devotional practices in this eight-session DVD study with well-known scholar Sandra Richter. Sessions: 1) The hymnbook of ancient Israel (27 min.); Who wrote the Psalms and why? (19 min.); 3) Interpreting the Psalms - sacred space (26 min.); 4) Interpreting the Psalms -theocracy (26 min.); 5) The power of poetry (19 min.); 6) Lord, like a shepherd lead us (26 min.); 7) The anatomy of a lament (24 min.); 8) Jesus and the Psalms (29 min.). **ONE: REACHING THE LOST WITH THE LOVE OF CHRIST (115029)** Author: Cowart, Jim and Cowart, Jennifer. A Bible study from Luke 15. Learn to see others through God's eyes. Think about the happy relief that floods through you when you find a lost cell phone or a misplaced set of keys. This is just the tiniest hint of what it feels like to reach out to the ones in our lives who are spiritually lost...who have not yet discovered the rich love God has for them. Plus, as the parables in Luke 15 show us, to save "the one" is a wonderful way to respond to God's great love. Jesus tells stories about rejoicing when lost things are found--specifically, a lost sheep, a lost coin, and a lost child. In this four-session DVD study, Jennifer and Jim Cowart use these parables to teach us how to become

passionate about sharing the love and message of Jesus to reach those who don't know God. Sessions: 1) You are the one (14 min.); 2) The sheep (15 min.); 3) The coin (11 min.); 4) The boys (17 min.). Includes study guide. **CLOSED CAPTIONED.** Age: Adult. 57 Minutes.



## READING THE OLD TESTAMENT THROUGH JEWISH EYES: A STUDY OF THE SCRIPTURES

**JESUS READ (118086)** Author: Moffic, Evan. Rabbi Evan Moffic has a passion for sharing Jewish faith and traditions with Christian audiences. In this six-session DVD study, Rabbi Moffic explores the first five books of the Hebrew Bible and highlights the key points of interest to Christians. He presents the biblical text and interpretations of it in the way Jewish leaders during the time of Jesus would have studied it while examining different commentaries from thousands of years of Jewish sources. The DVD supplements the study, but participants will need a copy of the paperback book for information not provided in the DVD. Sessions: 1) The Torah (6 min.); 2) Genesis (7 min.); 3) Exodus (7 min.); 4) Leviticus (7 min.); 5) Numbers (6 min.); 6) Deuteronomy (7 min.). Includes leader's guide and paperback book. **CLOSED CAPTIONED.** Age: Adult. 40 Minutes.



## ULTIMATE RELIANCE: BREAKTHROUGH PRAYER PRACTICES FOR LEADERS

**(121034)** Author: Kibbey, Sue Nilson. In this study, Sue Nilson Kibbey offers guidance on how to embrace and build five game-changing breakthrough prayer practices into daily life and leadership. The paperback book provides the main information; the DVD provides a video story to introduce each chapter's breakthrough prayer practice. Sessions: 1) Lead me to the rock that is higher than I (8 min.); 2) Be not afraid (12 min.); 3) Let there be light (7 min.); 4) Your will be done (12 min.); 5) Keep on asking, seeking, knocking (14 min.).
