



BAND MEETING: REDISCOVERING RELATIONAL DISCIPLESHIP IN TRANSFORMATIONAL COMMUNITY (102174) Author: Watson, Kevin and Kisker, Scott. In this eight-session DVD study, Kevin Watson and Scott Kisker explore the richness of Methodist band meetings. Similar to, but working on a deeper level than, a class meeting, a band meeting is a group of three to five people that is divided by gender, where the focus of each meeting is on confession of sin in order to grow in holiness. Sessions: 1) Banding together again (9 min.); 2) Creation, light, order, and abundant life (11 min.); 3) Salvation in the Wesleyan tradition (10 min.); 4) Salvation and community (14 min.); 5) The rise and fall of the early Methodist band meeting (15 min.); 6) How to start a band meeting (22 min.); 7) The keys to a thriving band meeting (17 min.); 8) A life-changing experience (13 min.). BLACK METHODISM: LEGACY OF FAITH -- REVIVAL (102049) This special anniversary DVD celebrates the 40th anniversary of several related and pivotal events in the life and history of The United Methodist Church: the end of the racially segregated Central Jurisdiction in 1967; the birth, through merger, of The United Methodist Church in 1968; the establishment of the General Commission on Religion and Race in 1968. 

Following the German and English Reformations, the storyline follows the development of United Methodism, showing its links with the entire Christian story. Includes guide. CLASS MEETING: RECLAIMING A FORGOTTEN (AND ESSENTIAL) SMALL GROUP

EXPERIENCE (103143) Author: Watson, Kevin. In this eight-session DVD study, Kevin Watson shares John Wesley's time-tested and proven method of small groups with today's church. A class meeting is a small group that is primarily focused on transformation, not information -- where people learn how to interpret their lives through the lens of the gospel, build a vocabulary for giving voice to their experience of God, and grow in faith in Christ. Sessions: 1) A new old kind of small group; 2) The class meeting -- the heart of the Methodist revival; 3) Moving into God's house -- the theological foundation of the class meeting; 4) Becoming Wesleyan again; 5) The basics -- from start to finish; 6) The roll of the class leader; 7) What could possibly go wrong?; 8) The keys to a life-changing group. This six-session DVD study is an engaging approach to discipleship from a distinctly Wesleyan perspective. Whether used as an introduction for new members or a renewal course for existing members, this study guides individuals to take the next step in discipleship and become dynamic, engaged followers of Jesus Christ. In this six-session DVD study, Elaine Heath and Joerg Rieger discuss five means of grace that John Wesley called 'instituted,' meaning these are spiritual practices that were instituted in the New Testament and are binding for all time and in all places. Sessions: 1) The means of grace are spiritual practices (16 min.); 2) Grace (19 min.); 3) Searching the Scriptures (14 min.); 4) The Lord's Supper (15 min.); 5) Fasting (14 min.); 6) Christian conferencing (14 min.). 
FORGED BY FIRE: UNTOLD STORIES OF FAITH (106016) This series of five extraordinary stories, told by United Methodist people with a commitment to being the church in a transformed society, takes root in the deeply complex historical struggles of their ancestors. These stories point to the resilience of the church and people of faith as they dare to act with freedom and with unity to restore community and resist dominant norms, behaviors, and perceptions that justify hate based on race, ethnicity, nationality, and language. Five segments: 1) U.S. Internment of Japanese American Communities (10 min.); 2) The Trail of Tears: Cherokee Forced Removal (9 min.); 3) Underground Railroad: African-American Passage to Freedom (7 min.); 4) When the Border Crosses over Us: Hispanic/Latino Struggles on the U.S. Mexican Border (12 min.); 5) The Newest Immigrants: Pacific Islanders (8 min.). JOHN WESLEY STORY (110045) This DVD includes two DVD segments for two age groups. 'The Faith that Sparked the Methodist Movement' is a 50-minute documentary on John Wesley for adults. Soundtrack and optional captioning available in English and Spanish for both segments. JOHN WESLEY, THE PROUD METHODIST (110012) This DVD documents the life of John Benjamin Wesley, the founder of Methodism, from his birth and upbringing in a deeply religious English country parsonage to his death 88 years later, when the church he never meant to start was already becoming an institution. Special attention is paid to the roots of the Methodist movement in Wesley's personality, events leading up to his 'true' conversion at Aldersgate, and emphases he placed on social equity and community service. Illustrated with period engravings, lithographs, and portraits. Age: Middle school - Adult. 27 Minutes.

JOHN WESLEY: THE MAN AND HIS MISSION (110057) Author: Garner, Keith. This documentary, hosted by Wesley expert Keith Garner and filmed at key locations, provides a comprehensive view of John Wesley's life and legacy. Also includes bonus segments (5 minutes each) of Keith discussing six of Wesley's sermons: Means of Grace; The Almost Christian; Salvation by Faith; God's Love for Fallen Man; The Marks of the New Birth; and The Catholic Spirit. Age: High school - Adult. 55 Minutes.

JOHN WESLEY'S 300TH BIRTHDAY: 11 VIDEO SEGMENTS (110039) Produced in commemoration of John Wesley's 300th birthday, this DVD includes eleven 1-minute segments on various aspects of his life and influence: Who was John Wesley?; John Wesley the organizer; John Wesley the preacher; John Wesley the publisher; Wesley and social concerns; Wesley and money; Wesley and the Epworth Rectory; Wesley in America; Wesley and opposition; Main themes of John Wesley's thought; Wesley's lasting influence. MEANS OF GRACE: TRADITIONED PRACTICE IN TODAY'S WORLD (113077) Author: Thompson, Andrew. In this ten-session DVD study, Andrew Thompson presents a clear and accessible explanation of the core tenets John Wesley instilled in the early Methodist movement. Each means of grace is drawn from biblical examples and paired with a framework to offer a practical model for a life marked by holy love and holy transformation. Sessions: 1) What does grace have to do with me? 




SCRIPTURE AND THE WESLEYAN WAY: A BIBLE STUDY ON REAL CHRISTIANITY


