Andrew Chandler (illustrator) and Philip Tallon (author and narrator) work together to bring catechesis to life for people of all ages, backgrounds, and stops along their spiritual journey. Each short (3 - 6 min.) DVD segment pairs with the book to spark conversation and move students to a deeper level of spiritual understanding. 
INVITATION: A BIBLE STUDY TO BEGIN WITH – REVISED EDITION (109069) Author: Russell, Brian. What is the Bible's message? How does it all fit together? In what ways does it speak to women and men hungry for truth in the 21st century? In this 10-session DVD study, Dr. Brian D. Russell serves as your guide through the narrative of Scripture: Creation, the Fall of Humanity, the Calling of Israel, the Life, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Sending of the Church, and New Creation.
