
LIGHT BULB CONSPIRACY: THE UNTOLD STORY OF PLANNED OBSOLESCENCE (112104) This DVD documentary uncovers how planned obsolescence has shaped our lives, economy, and environment since the 1920's, when manufacturers deliberately started shortening the life of consumer products to increase demand. The film also profiles a new generation of consumers, designers and business people who have started challenging planned obsolescence as an unsustainable economic driver. Two segments: a 52-minute version that is CLOSED CAPTIONED and a 74-minute version without captioning. Nine short bonus segments are also included. 






DEEPLY ROOTED: KNOWING SELF, GROWING IN GOD (817068)




