



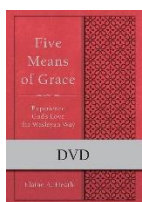

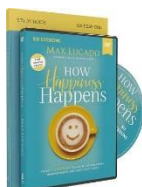

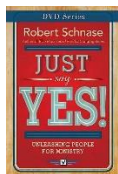

**FIVE MEANS OF GRACE: EXPERIENCE GOD'S LOVE THE WESLEYAN WAY (106081)** Author: Heath, Elaine and Rieger, Joerg. In this six-session DVD study, Elaine Heath and Joerg Rieger discuss five means of grace that John Wesley called 'instituted,' meaning these are spiritual practices that were instituted in the New Testament and are binding for all time and in all places. Sessions: 1) The means of grace are spiritual practices (16 min.); 2) Grace (19 min.); 3) Searching the Scriptures (14 min.); 4) The Lord's Supper (15 min.); 5) Fasting (14 min.); 6) Christian conferencing (14 min.). Designed for Minecraft fans, this book includes 60 devotions; each one includes a gameplay secret for Minecraft success, a Bible verse, a question for reflection or discussion, and a short devotional reading. Includes an index of topics and Bible verses. Can be used by parents and teachers as a contemporary way to discuss spiritual topics. Age: Upper elementary – Middle school. 253 Pages.



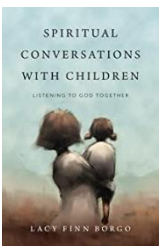
**DISCIPLER: AN INTERACTIVE GUIDE TO INTENTIONAL, RELATIONAL, ACCOUNTABLE DISCIPLESHIP (818042)** Author: Maynard, Phil and Pipkin, Eddie. Designed to be used by an individual or small group under the guidance of a mentor or spiritual director, this workbook is a daily practical guide with Scripture-based reflections and exercises that will help you grow towards maturity as a disciple of Jesus Christ. There are six weeks' worth of exercises for each of the growth phases -- Exploring; Beginning; Growing; Maturing. Within each weekly section there are six activities, one for each dimension of discipleship (worship, hospitality, openness to Jesus, obedience, service, and generosity), which leaves one day for Sabbath each week. 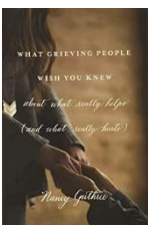
**JESUS AND NONVIOLENCE: A THIRD WAY (805100)** Author: Wink, Walter. More than ever, the author believes, the Christian tradition on nonviolence is needed as an alternative to the dominant and death-dealing 'powers' of our consumerist culture and fractured world. In this small book, he offers a precis of his whole thinking about this issue, including the relation of Jesus and his message to politics and nonviolence, the history of nonviolent efforts, and how nonviolence can win the day when others don't hesitate to resort to violence or terror to achieve their aims. **PREACHING IN THE PURPLE ZONE: MINISTRY IN THE RED-BLUE DIVIDE (821003)** Author: Schade, Leah. Chapters: Preaching about controversial justice issues – tracing the contours of the Purple Zone; Beyond 'political' – reframing our understanding of politics and preaching; Homiletical foundations for Purple Zone preaching; Five paths of prophetic preaching in the Purple Zone; Preparing for the sermon-dialogue-sermon process; Preaching sermon 1 – prophetic invitation to dialogue; Deliberate dialogue in the Purple Zone; Preaching sermon 2 – communal prophetic proclamation; Case studies from the Purple Zone, part 1 – immigration; Case studies, part 2 – four journeys into the Purple Zone; Building bridges in the Purple Zone - where do we go from here? How can we increase our capacity to engage children in spiritual conversations? In this book, Lacy Finn Borgo draws on her own experience of practicing spiritual direction with children. In this book you'll find: sample interactive dialogues with children; ideas for engaging children with play, art, and movement; and prayers to use together. Whether you are a parent or grandparent, pastor, or spiritual director, you will find this to be a friendly guide into deeper ways of listening.
