

Global Outreach Prayer List – January 2026

- Sorokogne** – Praying for continue building of our relationships with people and leaders in the village. We thank you, Lord, for our relationship with Chief Taha. We pray his faith in the Lord grows each day. Pray that Djibel Sine, the right-hand of Chief Taha remains open to Pastor Abdou. Pray that the parents see that an education for their children is important and send them to the village public school. We pray for a blessed school year for the students. Lord, guide us working with Bethesda Christian school so students from the village will be able to attend Bethesda Christian school in Your time. Prayers for the believers of Sorokogne that their faith will stay strong and grow. They will be filled with boldness to share the Good News with nonbelievers in the village. Lord, soften the hearts of the nonbelievers to hear the Word and accept Christ as their personal Savior. Lord shows us when and how to one day build a church building in the village if it is Your Will. Lord, bless and give direction to Pastor Abdou with leading the men’s ministry and Taki leading the women’s ministry. Lord, we thank you for Your blessing on the women’s project of renting out supplies for special occasions, giving microloans which are paid back with interest and for the men’s agricultural co-op which assists the villagers with seed and other supplies. Lord, we ask a blessing on the Kids club done by Pastor Abdou and Ibou Ndour. May the children learn about God’s love for them and accept Jesus as their Savior through this ministry. We ask for a blessing for the midwife working at the birth center in the village and for the head nurse at the medical clinic. Prayers that they will be moved to stay since they have no government support and staff are changing frequently. Pray for God’s guidance for Adventure of Faith if we should help in replacing the broken ambulance that serves the village to take patients to the regional hospital. We thank you Lord, that the government has provided a van for now to take patients to Kaffrine when needed. The head nurse is requesting an ultrasound and hospital beds. Lord, guide us about these requests so Your will be done. Lord, we also bring to You the grandson of MorYacine, who had his leg amputated some years ago and needs a new prosthesis. Guide us about this request also. Prayers for the right amount of rain during the rainy season for a good harvest. The Village is in the process of getting electricity from the Muslim Brotherhood that have the large mosque in the village. Lord, we ask that the people not be persuaded to Islam because of this but see You Are the Way.
- Kaffrine** – It is known across Senegal that the Kaffrine area is the most difficult to convert people for the kingdom. Some Senegalese believers have given up on this area saying it is too hard; the people are too set in their Muslim ways. We pray for a rising of believers in the Kaffrine area, which includes Sorokogne, so strong that all of Senegal will hear about it and know the power of God. Prayer of praise, Oh Lord for the printing of the first complete Wolof Bible which will be in print for everyone in March 2026 and for God’s Word to reach many around Senegal. We give thanks for your faithful servant Corey Garrett in helping with the translation of the Bible into the Wolof language. Pray for the Islamic religious leaders called Marabout that they would come to the Lord creating a large movement forward in Christian believers. Pray for the children living on the streets as Talibe boys under the rule of the Marabout that God would provide for their needs of food, shelter, education, and Christian spiritual training so that they would break away from the rule of the Marabout. We thank you, Lord for Babacar’s ministry with the Talibe boys in Thies. We ask for continue blessing on his ministry as he tells them about Jesus and teaches them to repair cars so they can someday provide for themselves. Prayers for Senegal for social stability and stop the inflatable cost of living and pray for good leadership at the head of the country. A good understanding between the President and his Prime Minister of the Executive branch. Pray for a spiritual impact through the church.

3. **Pastor Abdourhamen Fall** – Prayer of thanksgiving for Pastor Abdourahmane Fall. Pray for God's hands and peace be upon Pastor Abdou as he fulfills God's call to the Kaffrine area. We pray that the Holy Spirit will speak through him to the villagers in Sorokogne in his sharing. Ask the Lord to continue opening doors in Sorokogne for Pastor Abdou to share boldly the love of Christ and the gospel message. God show him Your will and bless it as he builds relationships through the adult ministry. Lord thank you for Jean Baptiste as he is translator during zoom meetings with our team and Pastor Abdou. Prayers for safe travel for Jean Baptiste from Thies to Kaffrine when he can come. Jean asks for prayers in strengthening his relationship with EEBT church (Baptist church of Thies). Pastor Abdou and Jean ask for prayer for unity in the leadership of the EEBT church. Pray for newly elected leaders Jim Pina, president of the CIP and Georges Thiandoum, vice president of the CIP at EEBT church. Pray they will continue good relations and collaboration with Pastor Abdou for the ministry in Sorokogne. Pray for God's guidance and blessings for Pastor Abdou and Taki with the House church they started. Prayers that more people will come on Sundays and Thursdays. Pray that EEBT church will support them in their House church. Prayers for continued good relations with their neighbors. Pray for God's guidance and blessings on starting a Christian community radio program from Pastor Abdou home with the help from Pastor Ahmeth Fall which would help the ministry in Kaffrine and Sorokogne. Continue to pray for God's guidance for the Adventure Outreach team as they discuss if and how they should help Pastor Abdou buy a house in Kaffrine instead of renting. Prayer for good health for Pastor Abdou, Taki and sons, Samuel, and Jacque. Pray that God will heal Jacque's hyperactivity issues. Lord, bless the boys during this school year.
