## What we do:

Our mission is to connect kids and their families with Jesus Christ and equip them to live the adventure of faith. This is true for kids as young as babies in our nursery, up to our preteens in 5th grade.

# **Opportunities to serve:**

- Sundays during Adventure Equip Multi-age class for preschool through 5th grade. Volunteers typically serve each Sunday for the full session of equip (~6-12 weeks)
- Sundays during Worship Service Classes for kids from birth through 5th grade, divided into age/grade levels. Volunteers typically serve on a rotating basis, scheduled for one to two Sundays per month. The duration for serving is up to the volunteer, but we do ask for a commitment of at least 3 months.
- Wednesdays during BaseCamp After dinner activities, bible teaching, and discussion for toddlers through 5th grade. Volunteers typically commit to serving for one session of BaseCamp, or one school year term from October-May.
- Substituting Rather than committing to a schedule, our substitutes are called upon as needs arise.

# Adventure: Kids Team Expectations

### **Characteristics of Adventure: Kids volunteers:**

- Faithful These are people who are faithful in their relationship with God and with others. They live life with integrity (they do what they say they are going to do) and others can attest to it.
- Available These are people who not only have the passion but the physical and emotional space in their lives to love a class of children.
- Teachable These are people who demonstrate a spirit to follow the lead of others and are willing to submit to leadership both in ministry and personal life.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Follow Adventure: Kids policies and Adventure of Faith Leader Code of Conduct.
- Complete a background check (for ages 18 and above).
- Be prepared for class by reading curriculum ahead of time
- Make connections with kids and parents
- Pray for the kids in your class regularly
- Attend Main Service in person on off-weeks of serving, and watch virtually after serving.
- Communicate with the team
- Attend team meetings (once or twice a year)
- Maintain regular attendance in Adventure: Kids class on assigned Sundays
