

Global Outreach Prayer List - April 2025

1. **Sorokogne** – Praying for continue building of our relationships with people and leaders in the village. We thank you, Lord, for our relationship with Chief Taha. We pray his faith in the Lord grows each day. Pray that the parents see that an education for their children is important and send them to the village public school. Pray for God's blessing for this school year. Lord, guide us working with Bethesda Christian school so students from the village will be able to attend Bethesda Christian school in Your time. Prayers for the believers of Sorokogne that their faith will stay strong and grow. They will be filled with boldness to share the Good News with nonbelievers in the village. Lord, soften the hearts of the nonbelievers to hear the Word and accept Christ as their personal Savior. Lord shows us when and how to one day build a church building in the village if it is Your Will. We thank you Lord in the meantime for the Man of Peace of the village opening his compound for Pastor Abdou to do Your ministry weekly. Bless Pastor Abdou and Taki in leading the adult ministry and give them direction with this ministry. Lord, we thank you for the seven women from the village that visited Pastor Abdou and Taki at their home. The women affirmed their complete and total availability for the teaching of the Word of God on Tuesday afternoons when Pastor Abdou and Taki go to the village. We pray the women's faith grows. Lord, we thank you for Your blessing on the women's project of renting out supplies for special occasions and expansion of this service and for the men's agricultural co-op. Lord, we ask a blessing on the Kids club done by Pastor Abdou and Ibo Ndour. May the children learn about God's love for them and accept Jesus as their Savior through this ministry. We ask for a blessing for the midwife working at the birth center in the village and for the head nurse at the medical clinic. Prayers that they will be moved to stay since they have no government support and staff are changing frequently. Pray that God will show the mayor of Kaffrine how to replace the broken ambulance that serves in the village to take patients to the regional hospital. Prayers for a good harvest of watermelon since the peanut harvest was only 20% normal this year due to a poor rainy season. The Village is in the process of getting electricity from the Muslim Brotherhood that have the large mosque in the village. Lord, we ask that the people not be persuaded to Muslim because of this but see You Are the Way.
2. **Kaffrine** – It is known across Senegal that the Kaffrine area is the most difficult to convert people for the kingdom. Some Senegalese believers have given up on this area saying it is too hard; the people are set in their Muslim ways. We pray for a rising of believers in the Kaffrine area, which includes Sorokogne and Diagle, so strong that all of Senegal will hear about it and know the power of God. Pray for the Islamic religious leaders called Marabout that they would come to the Lord creating a large movement forward in Christian believers. Pray for the children living on the streets as Talibe boys under the rule of the Marabout that God would provide for their needs of food, shelter, education, and Christian spiritual training so that they would break away from the rule of the Marabout. We pray that the Senegalese government will enforce the plan to end child begging. We thank you, Lord for Babacar's ministry with the Talibe boys in Thies. We ask for continue blessing on his ministry as he tells them about Jesus and teaches them to repair cars so they can provide for themselves. Pastor Abdou asks us to pray these prayers for their country—economic situation, political situation—the new President and Prime Minister work well together and general insecurity with killings and road safety.
3. **Pastor Abdourahmen Fall** – Prayer of thanksgiving for Pastor Abdourahmane Fall. Pray for God's hands and peace be upon Pastor Abdou as he fulfills God's call to the Kaffrine area. We pray that the Holy Spirit will speak through him to the villagers in Sorokogne in his sharing. Ask the Lord to continue opening doors in Sorokogne for Pastor Abdou to share boldly the

love of Christ and the gospel message. God show him Your will and bless it as he builds relationships through the adult ministry. Lord thank you that Jean Baptiste is the in-country outreach person for Pastor Abdou and translator during zoom meetings with our team and Pastor Abdou. Prayers for safe travel for Jean Baptiste from Thies to Kaffrine when he can come. Jean asks for prayers in strengthening his relationship with EEBT church. Pastor Abdou and Jean ask for prayer for unity in the leadership of the EEBT church. Pastor Abdou thanks God that his relationship with EEBT (Baptist Church of Thies) church has improved. Pray for God to show Pastor Abdou how to provide for provision to continue his theological education. Pray for God's guidance and blessings for Pastor Abdou and Taki with the House church they started. They are facing some difficulties since so much is done in the community, it is hard for individuals to come. Pray that EEBT (Baptist church) will support them in their House church. Pastor Abdou is asking we pray for Toure, Mother Ndoura, Pa Siop and Imam Lou. They are encouragers/supporters in the House church. Prayers for continued good relations with their neighbors. Continue to pray for God's guidance for the Adventure Outreach team as they discuss if they should help Pastor Abdou buy a house in Kaffrine instead of renting. Prayer for good health for Pastor Abdou, Taki and sons, Samuel, and Jacque. Prayers of praise that all the tests have come back that Taki does not have breast cancer. She has been cleared. Pray that God will heal Jacque's hyperactivity issues. He is having a tough time focusing. Pray for Samuel and Jacques to have a successful school year. Their state school exams come up at the end of this school year. Prayers, they both do well.

4. **Outreach Ministry Team** – We ask for God's guidance and wisdom for the administration team, prayer team, trip planning team, the student sponsorship coordinator, the Outreach store team, and the Awaken Cafe team as they work together to support projects for Bethesda Christian school, the Village of Sorokogne, and Mazatlán. Lord, guide and bless these projects. Lord, we thank you for the continuing growth of relationships our travel teams have made and sharing the gospel with the people in the village of Sorokogne, Kaffrine and Mazatlán. We ask for continue growing of these seeds so they will accept Jesus as their Savior. Pray for God's guidance for Judy Munger and Jennifer Young for planning the next trip to Senegal in 2025. Pray for God's guidance for Tanya Hawkins for planning the next trip to Mazatlán.
5. **Pastor Benoit Boubane** – We pray for Pastor Bennit Boubane, at Temple Ebenizer church in Kaffrine. Bless his ministry in this community and help bring people to Jesus. Pray for God's guidance and blessings for Pastor Boubane relationship to grow with the Ebenezer church and the elders in the church as there are challenges. Pray the pastor to have discernment to make necessary corrections or changes. Pray for God's blessings and growth in the relationship with Pastor Abdou and Pastor Boubane. Lord, we ask for Your safe keeping and blessings on the people of this church. Prayers that Pastor Abdou can re-establish the radio ministry through a different station in Kaffrine because the radio ministry has been halted for now. We ask for God's safe keeping and good health for Pastor Boubane, his wife, Sophie, sons, Emmanuel, and Jonathan.
6. **Bethesda Christian School** – We ask for God's blessings on the students and teachers this school year. We thank God for the Christian teachers and office workers that God has provided for Bethesda. Lord, we thank you as You continue to build up Christian teachers and school personal not only at Bethesda but at all the Christian schools in Senegal. Lord, we thank you for the teacher training by DECADES and RICE that is funded and will be providing Christian teachers to Christian schools. We pray God will touch each student's heart to come to Him and have a personal relationship with Him. That the gospel message

being shared will grow and flourish not only in the children but also in their families. We thank God for the headmaster, Babou Diouf. We ask for God's guidance and blessings as he leads the Bethesda Christian school in God's ministry. Pray for a good relationship between Adventure of Faith and Headmaster Babou. Lord, we thank you for the addition of the school which will be secondary classrooms allowing children to stay through 10th grade. God, we ask for your blessing on the fund raiser in furnishing these new classrooms. Pray for good health and protection for Headmaster Babou and his family.

7. **Sponsorship** – Thank you Lord for all the families at Adventure who are sponsoring children to attend Christian schools in Senegal and feeding centers in Mazatlán. Guide them as they build a relationship with their student. We thank you Lord for the opportunity to write letters to our students this month. We thank God for the wonderful letters we receive from our students too. May it be a blessing for all. Pray more people will come forth to be student sponsors at Bethesda and in Mazatlán. We give God all the praise. Hold Yvette Kinkpe in your prayers as she works for Go on the Mission as the student sponsorship coordinator in Dakar, Thies, Kaolack, Burkina Faso and Kaffrine. Ask the Lord to give her continued wisdom as she collaborates with the headmasters of each school improving communication between Go on the Mission, the schools, students, and sponsors. We pray for protection and good health for Yvette and her family in Dakar. We also pray for the Lord to provide the needs for the higher education facilities in Senegal as they are struggling to keep up with the demand; not enough teachers/professors for the number of students who want to attend. They must wait years or go to another country for their higher education.

8. **Pam Schubert, missionary** – Hold Pam in prayer as she serves in Türkiye with the University students and Antalya Evangelical church teams. May she feel the guiding of the Holy Spirit in sharing the Word of God with the students and church teams. We thank God for the email we received from Pam in March. She asks us to continue praying for Emre's wife to be granted a visa. Wisdom for Emre in supporting students and staff. She also asks that we pray for the student leaders who are scattered across the country, they may be encouraged in faith and be guided by the Holy Spirit as they share the hope they have. Another prayer is the 501c3 started by previous co-workers 13 years ago, which their current ministry hoped to use, has had to close. They are now opening a new one. Prayers for this process, that they all do the paperwork properly. Pray also for the women groups that Pam leads in Bible study at the Antalya church.

9. **Rafiki** – Prayer of praise for the orphans living in the 10 villages in Africa that they will come to know Jesus as their Savior. Pray for the full funding of 3500 Rafiki students and orphans, and all those children and students would come to know God early and become godly contributors. Pray that one hundred twenty schools in Africa will be using Rafiki Bible study and curriculum by June 2025. Pray for wisdom as Rafiki stewards all the resources

God has given them and enable the distribution of every Bible, Bible study, Sunday school lesson, Home Devotion page and school curriculum to bear fruit. Prayers for wisdom for the leaders as they talk with the older residents about their future vocations and choose a path suited for each student. Lift up in prayer the Widows program that their relationship with God grows stronger, pray their children will grow to be godly contributors to society, and for their health and safety. Prayers of thanks for the safe travel for Karen Carter and the Home staff from FL that visited six Rafiki Villages in East Africa in late February to early March.

10. **Mazatlán** – Thank you, Lord, for our mission team to Mazatlán under the leadership of Tanya Hawkins. Thank you, Lord, for the renewed friendship between our team and the people in Mazatlán. We ask the Lord to continue to grow and bless the seeds the teams planted in the children's hearts in sharing the gospel, so they will accept Jesus as their Savior.
