SHEPHERD'S HOPE

The Food Pantry is open on Tues and Thurs from 10 am until 2 pm; and Sat. from 9 am - 12 pm. The Feeding Center operates Mon, Wed, and Fri. 12 pm - 2 pm and Sat. at 9 am - 11 am. Shepherd's Hope hosts prayer meetings on Wednesdays, Friday night events, and a Saturday bible study. We have a clothing donation center that runs by appointment.

FIRST DEFENSE LEGAL AID
