We are sad to share that, due to the continuing COVID-19 crisis, all GLCO performances have been cancelled through November 30, 2020. While this news may not be surprising given the events of the past few months, it is heartbreaking, nonetheless. Sharing in the communal experience of live music is at the heart of what we do, and we know it is a vital part of your life too.

FAQs

What is happening in Spring 2021 – the second half of the 20/21 season?

We don't know yet. While these concerts have not yet been cancelled, we know that everything from seating configurations to musician availability and audience attendance will be impacted by the pandemic.

What is the GLCO doing during this time?

While the GLCO venues – The Great Lakes Center for the Arts and community churches are either closed or severely restricted, the ongoing support of donors has enabled us to launch several new online initiatives, including [GLCO In Concert](#), [Little Bay Concerts](#) and [Tuesday Talks](#).
