Lehigh University's 2021 Fazlur R. Khan Distinguished Lecture Series continues with two more online presentations in the weeks ahead:

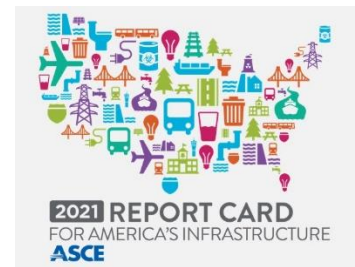

LVASCE 100th ANNIVERSARY

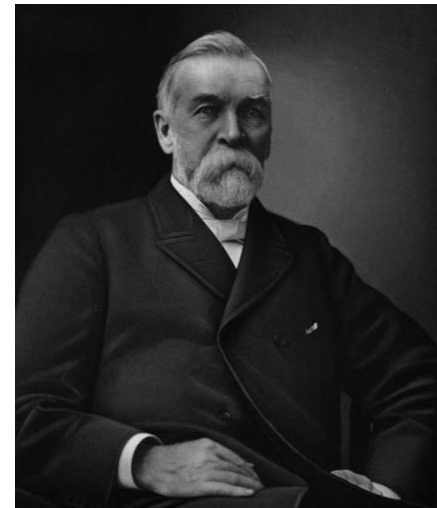
