Yen,** who served as a faculty member in Lehigh University's Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering from 1963 until his retirement in 2001. Greg Kuklinski worked with Professor Yen on developing and refining the tour for nearly 15 years before Ben passed the torch to Greg. Ben died in September 2020 at age 88, but the Bethlehem Bridge Tour continues to honor the memory of this exemplary teacher, researcher, and mentor.
