

OUR LITTLEST LANCERS IN THE CLASSROOM

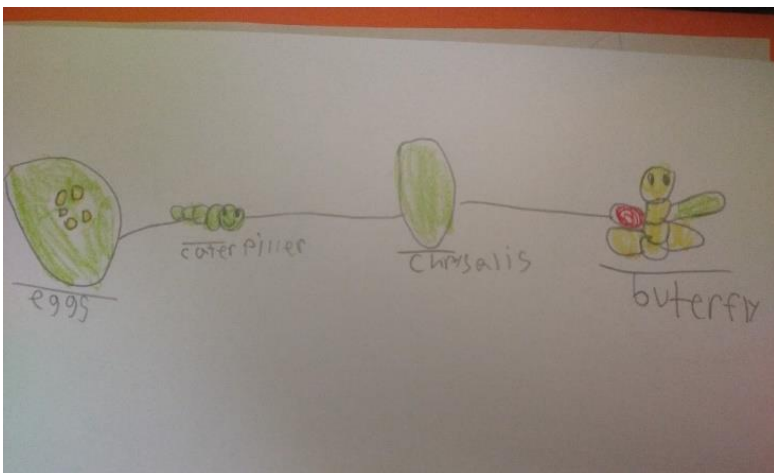

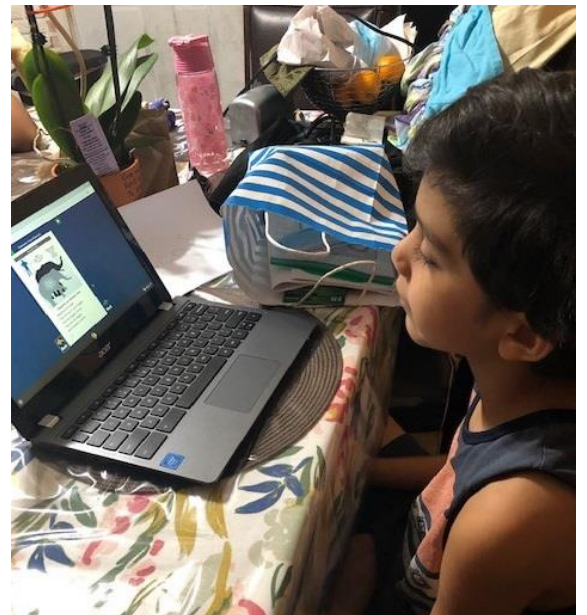
HND Director, Mr. Frank, gives a 'thumbs up' with First Grader, Francisco.



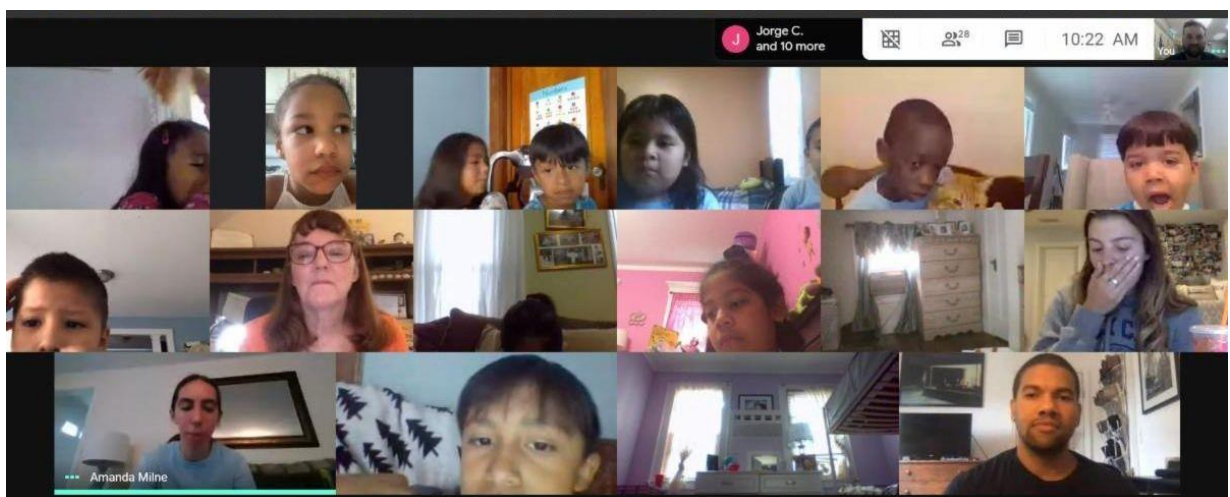
Cousins Jeremy, First Grader, and Makayla, Second Grader, are happy to receive their care packages!
