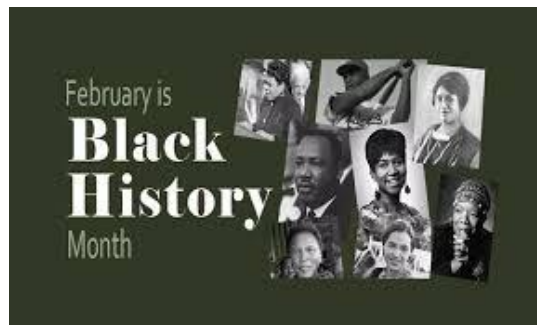


LANCER PRIDE
