## **Exam Dates**

Exams will be administered from May 11 - May 22, 2020.

Each exam will be taken on the same day and the same time worldwide. (If you will be somewhere other than the Eastern Standard time zone on the day of your scheduled exam, check the College Board website for adjusted test time.)

**Please remember that you must make sure that you are receiving e-mails from the collegeboard in order to receive your e-ticket 2 days before your test date.**

It is essential that students and parents click on the links and take time to review these items so that any questions you may have can be answered prior to the AP Exam test days. Also, please note the **"Confirm Your Email Address" link**. This link allows you to confirm or change your email if needed. It is extremely important that students verify the email address they are using to receive important AP information and their AP Exam e-tickets for exam day. Please look out for emails from collegeboard@e.collegeboard.org. The College Board has emphasized that students make sure they update/confirm their College Board/MyAP accounts with accurate email information. They have also advised that students use the "safe sender" function with their email providers. The College Board has suggested that students check their spam/junk folders to see if messages have been filtered to that location. Students will also be able to access their exam through their College Board MyAP account if email is inaccessible.
