

The Annual Ernie DiMattia Emerging Young Artist Scholarship Awards

ATTN STUDENTS: All materials must be received on or before February 20, 2017

The 3rd Annual Emerging Young Artist Scholarship Awards for Playwriting will be awarded to three high school students for their writing of an original Fifteen-minute, One Act play.

The criteria have been established by renowned playwrights, actors and directors and the applicants must meet the following requirements:

Criteria for the Play

- 1. Students must be in grades nine through twelve
- 2. The play needs to be written by one person
- 3. It must be written for four characters or fewer between the ages of 15-25 years old
- 4. It must be set in one location
- 5. The set needs to be light and props (if any) must be hand held or small
- 6. Plays are best when the dialogue stays mostly in the **present tense**. Try to avoid characters telling each other what happened before the scene. Make the action about what happens NOW.
- 7. Be certain your play is actable, and not written as a screen play.

Submit your play in a form that clearly distinguishes between characters speaking, their dialogue, and the stage directions. If you're in doubt, copying the format of a published play should be acceptable.
