




THE LATEST FROM THE CLASSROOM

Using materials found in their homes like powdered make-up, graphite pencils, markers, cinnamon, baby powder, tape, and computer paper, students learned the proper technique used by criminalists when rolling fingerprints and lifting latent prints found at crime scenes. Each student created a fingerprint card and analyzed several prints to identify patterns such as whorls, loops, and arches.
